DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to one Carolyn L. Woltz of Columbus, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$36.00, payable in semiannual installments of \$18.00 each, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site and landing purposes, the inner slope and waterfront and the outer slope and borrow pit in the rear thereof that is included in embankment Lot No. 44, south of Lakeside, as laid out by the Ohio Canal Commission in 1905, and being part of the northeast quarter of Section 28, Town 17, Range 18, Fairfield

County, Ohio. Said lot has a frontage of 100 feet measured along the top of the outer slope of the reservoir embankment.
