**Narrative:**

On Saturday, August 05, 2023, at 0446 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Russell (SA Russell) interviewed Columbus Police Department (CPD) Officer (Ofc.) Karl Eiginger (Eiginger). The interview took place at the intersection of South High and Rowe Street, Columbus, Ohio. The interview was audio recorded.

Eiginger was identified as being a police officer who witnessed and/or had some level of involvement in the August 5, 2023 officer-involved shooting which occurred in the area of South High and Rowe Street, Columbus, Ohio. Reportedly, Eiginger did not discharge a firearm during the course of the incident.

The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this officer.

Eiginger stated he was working a special duty assignment as cruiser 240 (Capital Crossroads) with CPD officer Canaan Dick (Dick) as his partner. Eiginger advised he and Dick responded to radio traffic of an officer involved with a subject with possible "excited delirium", requesting a medic. Eiginger added, while in route he heard the officer/car [REDACTED] later identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] radio that he had "shots fired". Eiginger advised that Dick then activated his lights, siren, and drove faster to assist. Eiginger stated, that CPD car 133 also arrived on scene as he did and approached [REDACTED] who had the suspect, later identified as Zachary Logan (Logan), handcuffed and performing medical aid, chest compressions. Eiginger stated that he saw another CPD officer relieve [REDACTED] and escort him from the immediate scene and another took over rendering aid to Logan. Eiginger added a short time later an

ambulance responded and transported Logan to Grant Medical Center.

Eiginger advised that he assisted with putting up crime scene tape and then that was the end of his involvement in this incident, he waited on scene to be interviewed.

The interview concluded at approximately 0450 hours.
