Narrative:

On Thursday, January 30, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (SA Harasimchuk) received a previously requested "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that Mason French possessed during the incident on January 16, 2025. The report provided details about the Beretta, model BU9 NANO 9mm firearm, bearing a serial number of NUO13539, including that it was purchased by [REDACTED] on [REDACTED].

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) check of the weapon was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen. According to the report, [REDACTED].
