Narrative:

On April 7, 2026, at approximately 1130 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent John Tingley (SA Tingley) contacted Harrison County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) [REDACTED] at the HCSO which is located at 978 East Market Street, Cadiz, Harrison County, Ohio, 43907.

[REDACTED] was an involved law enforcement Officer in the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred on March 30, 2026, in the 31000 block of US Route 250, Uhrichsville, Harrison County, Ohio. [REDACTED] was not contacted on the date of the OICI due to his receiving treatment for his injuries sustained during the OICI, with said treatment being given at the West Virginia University (WVU) Hospital in Wheeling, West Virginia (BCI SA Bynum went to the WVU hospital in Wheeling, but upon SA Bynum's arrival, [REDACTED] had already been treated and released).

SA Tingley introduced himself to [REDACTED] and explained the process regarding the BCI investigation. As [REDACTED] has an attorney who has been in contact with BCI in regard to setting up an interview with [REDACTED] SA Tingley did not ask any questions of [REDACTED] SA Tingley notified [REDACTED] that any further contact with BCI agents would occur once a date and time is set up for the interview and that all contact between BCI Agents and [REDACTED] would be handled through [REDACTED] attorney.
