Narrative:

On Sunday, October 12, 2025, BCI SA John Saraya responded to an Officer Involved Critical Incident in the City of Warren. Multiple agencies had been involved in a vehicle and foot pursuit that led to the incident. SA Saraya traveled to the Trumbull County Sheriff's Office in regard to this investigation.

SA Saraya was escorted to a roll call room and introduced to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Also present was Dan Leffler from the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (OPBA). The deputies' firearms had already been collected. They were photographed and informed of the procedures. Both declined an interview at this time. Information was shared with the OPBA representative to coordinate for interviews. The photos taken of the deputies were uploaded for storage.

SA Saraya then met with Major Douglas Bobovynik. Copies of booking information on BAILEY and radio logs were provided. Maj. Bobovynik stated that he would begin collecting the documentation necessary and would have it available in the next few days. Maj. Bobovynik also stated the agency has body worn cameras, however, they have not been issued as yet.

SA Saraya cleared from the Sheriff's Office and returned to the scene to assist the Crime Scene Unit.
