Narrative:

On September 07, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Ryan Scheiderer (SA Scheiderer) received a report from the BCI Laboratory Firearms section documenting their finding regarding the firearms evidence that was submitted and tested from this incident.
