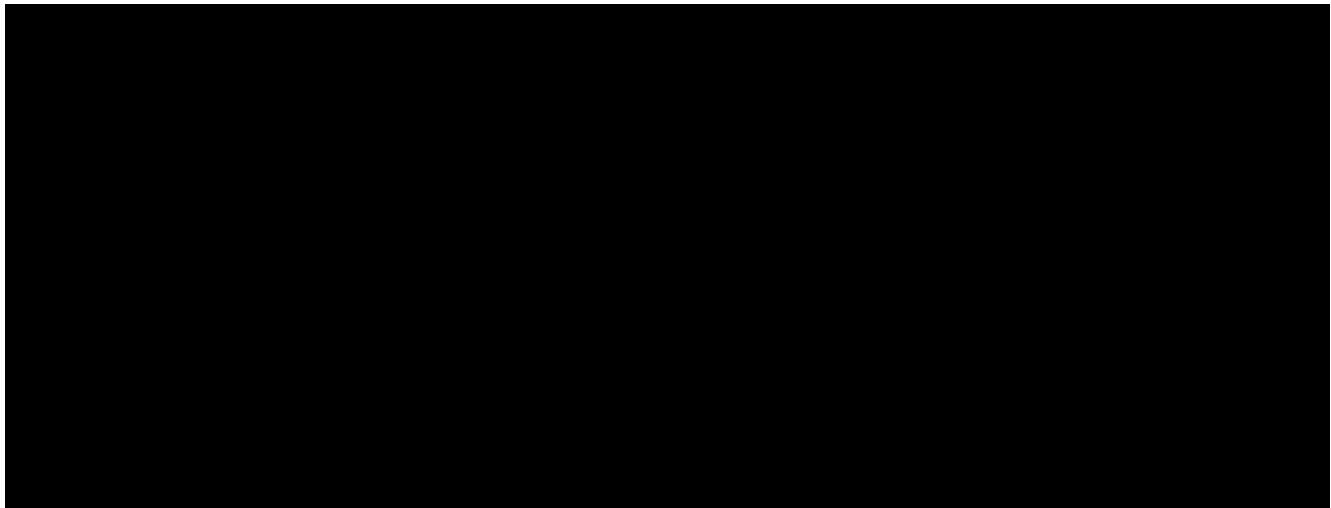
Narrative:

Officer Rodriguez states " [REDACTED] arrived on scene first and CAR207 Officer Kaleugher and myself arrived shortly after. [REDACTED] began knocking on the door to make contact and Office Kaleugher was behind him on the front steps and I was behind Kaleugher. After the knock there was gunfire and myself and Kaleugher ran towards the back yard incase the suspect tried to flee from the rear of the house, While making it to the rear yard we overheard [REDACTED] advise the suspect was down. Officer Kaleugher entered the residence and I returned back to our cruiser for a first aid kit ". Officer Rodriguez advised she was unsure how [REDACTED] made entry after the gunfire.

I then spoke with Officer Kaleugher and was advised, " We were SVR to [REDACTED] for a fight with weapon and we arrived a minute after [REDACTED] did, [REDACTED] was already knocking on the door as we were approaching the front door steps. One of the residents opened the door and the suspect started shooting at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was inside the doorway returning fire so I started to make my way to the rear of the house incase the suspect tried to flee from the rear of the house. We made it half way through the driveway before [REDACTED] advised the suspect was down ".

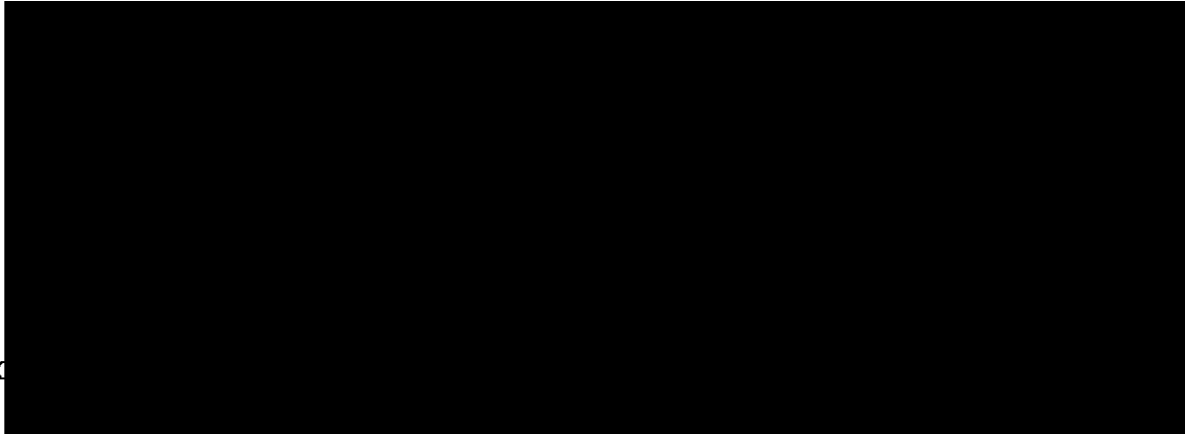

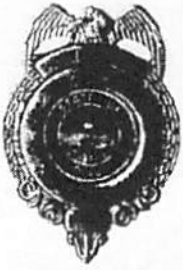
