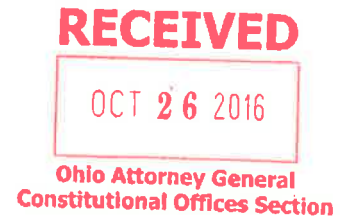

Pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 3519.01(A), I am submitting to you a written petition signed by at least one thousand qualified electors proposing a constitutional amendment. As you will note, the petition includes a proposed summary and the full text of the proposed constitutional amendment, as well as identifies the members of the committee to represent the petitioners in all matters relating to the petition.

**Petition Submitted to the Attorney General for
Certification of Summary of Proposed Amendment to the Constitution**
as required under Ohio Revised Code 3519.01(A)

SUMMARY

This amendment would add two new provisions to the Ohio Constitution:

- (i) a new division (D) to Section 6 of Article IV of the Ohio Constitution to prohibit any person from being elected or appointed as a judge to the Ohio Supreme Court if, at the time of being elected or appointed, such person has served nine or more consecutive years as a judge of the Ohio Supreme Court regardless of whether as chief justice, a justice, or a combination of the two;

and

- (ii) a new Section 43 to Article II of the Ohio Constitution to provide that all laws that apply to the people of the State of Ohio and its political subdivisions shall apply equally to the members and employees of the Ohio General Assembly.

FULL TEXT OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Be it Resolved by the People of the State of Ohio that Article IV, Section 6, of the Ohio Constitution is hereby amended by adopting a new division (D) thereto; and that Article II of the Ohio Constitution is hereby amended by adopting a new Section 43 thereto, said provisions to read as follows:

Article IV, Section 6.

(D) No person shall be elected or appointed as a judge of the Supreme Court if said person, at the time of said election or appointment, has served nine or more consecutive years as a judge of the Supreme Court regardless of whether as chief justice, a justice, or a combination of the two.

Article II, Section 43.

All laws that apply to the people of the State of Ohio and its political subdivisions shall apply equally to the members and employees of the General Assembly.

STATEMENT OF CIRCULATOR
