APPROVAL, RESERVOIR LAND LEASE—JACK R. REED.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, October 10, 1933.

HON. EARL H. HANEFELD, *Director, Department of Agriculture, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR:—The conservation division in your department, acting through the chief of the bureau of inland lakes and parks, has submitted for my examination and approval a reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the conservation commissioner to one Jack R. Reed of Akron, Ohio. This lease is one for a term of fifteen years and the same provides for an annual rental of eighteen dollars, payable in semi-annual installments of nine dollars each.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the conservation commissioner and by Jack R. Reed, the lessee therein named. I further find, upon examination of the provisions of the lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with the section of the General Code under authority of which the lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.

APPROVAL, RESERVOIR LAND LEASE—W. A. COCHRAN.
