APPROVAL, TWO LEASES TO CANAL LANDS IN FAIRFIELD AND PIKE COUNTIES.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, June 4, 1932.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of your recent communication submitting for my examination and approval two certain canal land leases in triplicate, by which there are leased to the respective lessees therein named certain parcels of abandoned Ohio Canal lands, which parcels are more fully described in said lease instruments.

The leases here in question, which are each for a term of fifteen years and provide for an annual rental of six per cent upon the appraised valuation thereof, are designated with respect to the names of the respective lessees, the location of the land and the appraised valuation thereof, as follows:

William C. Joest, Section 4, Town 16, Range 18, Fairfield County, \$200.00.

Charles C. Plum, Newton Township, Pike County, \$166.67.

Upon an examination of the leases above referred to, I find that the same have been properly executed by the Superintendent of Public Works and by the respective lessees therein named. I also find upon examination of these lease instruments that the provisions thereof and the conditions and restrictions therein contained are in conformity with each and all of the statutory provisions relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving these leases as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon said leases and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
