Narrative:

On July 27 and August 7, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Kyle Douglass (SA Douglass) received training, firearms qualification, and personnel file records from Cambridge Police Department (CPD) Captain Dave Peoples (Cpt. Peoples) for CPD [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. After reviewing these records, SA Douglass noted the following:

Use of Force History:

Prior to the incident on June 15, 2023, [REDACTED] had one record of a use of force incident which was considered inconsistent with CPD's Use of Force Policy:

- November 24, 2016

Per the employee report, a CPD supervisor conducted a Use of Force Policy review with [REDACTED] but there were no indications that [REDACTED] had been disciplined as a result of this incident or any other use of force incidents.

Disciplinary:

Prior to the incident on June 15, 2023, [REDACTED] had two records of disciplinary action CPD policy violations:

- December 17, 2019
- November 24, 2021

Per the employee report, [REDACTED] received written reprimands as a result of each of these CPD policy violations.

While assisting Lt. DeLancey and [REDACTED] locate four unknown suspects who ran on foot from a vehicle, Ptl. Oliver and I observed four subjects matching the description provided walking north on 7th St. at McKinley Ave. We identified ourselves as Police and ordered to the subjects to stop.

The two males stopped. The females fled on foot after being told to stop. The males were identified and released. Ptl. Oliver and I located the two females hiding next to 1003 North 7th St.

Kayla Resavage and Cortney Ball were taken into custody and transported to the Guernsey County Jail. They are both charged with Obstructing Official Business. They are to appear in the Cambridge Municipal Court on 6-24-2014 at 0830 AM.

While on patrol units 4 and [REDACTED] observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed heading north bound on N 5th St. At this time units 4 and [REDACTED] caught up to the vehicle as it pulled over in front of 624 Mckinley. At this time we observed 5 occupants exit the vehicle and walked towards the residence. As we passed the residence the subjects did not walk into the residence, but south bound down an alley next to the residence. At this time we turned around to make contact with the subjects and as we pulled down the alley the subjects were gone. We proceeded south down the alley in an attempt to locate the subjects. As we turned onto Harrison Ave we observed a male walking south on N 7th who matched the description of the driver of the vehicle.

At this time we exited our vehicle and approached the male, identifying ourselves as police, and ordered the male to stop. The male turned, looked at us, and took off running. While chasing the male he was ordered to several times to stop in which he did not comply. The male was tackled by unit [REDACTED] at N 7th and Sherman Ave and placed under arrest. While patting down the male, we found keys in his pocket.

The male was identified as Anthony L Stevenson. At this time we drove back up to Mckinley Ave, where vehicle was located. The vehicle's license plate number, GEQ7645, came back to the arrestee, Anthony L Stevenson. Unit [REDACTED] took the keys that were found on Stevenson and hit the unlock button, in which the vehicle unlocked. At this time we asked Stevenson if he wanted us to secure his vehicle for him, in which he advised officers to leave his vehicle as is (This conversation was recorded).

At this time we transported Stevenson to the Guernsey County Jail, and was charged with obstructing official business. Stevenson's court date was set for 6-24-14 at 8:30pm at the Cambridge Municipal Court.

While on patrol officers were dispatched to 716 S 8th St in reference to a male, David A Acton, staying at the residence who has active warrants. At this time officers made contact with the homeowner while additional officers watched the back of the residence. The homeowner David L Acton, led officers inside the residence. Once inside the residence officers made contact with David A Acton in the living room. Once officers made contact with Acton, Acton was placed under arrest and into hand restraints.

Officers escorted Acton out of the residence when he pulled away and started to flee on foot. At this time officers chased Acton and was tackled moments later. Once on the ground Acton was still actively resisting trying to kick at officers and trying to get back to his feet. Once officers gained control of Acton he passively resisted by going limp and resisting to stand up. Officers were able to control Acton and escort him to the cruiser. Once at the cruiser Acton was being very disorderly towards officers and would not get into the cruiser on his own. At this time officers had to force Acton into the cruiser. Once inside the cruiser Acton proceeded to kick the door of the cruiser so officers could not close the door. Once the door of the cruiser was closed, David A Acton was transported to the Guernsey County Jail.

Once at the jail Acton was complaining of shoulder and ankle pain. At this time officers escorted Acton to SEORMC to get evaluated. Once evaluated officers transported Acton back to the Guernsey County Jail. Once at the Jail officers served Acton with his warrants as well as additional charges of obstructing and resisting arrest. Acton has a court date set for 10-22-14 at 8:30am at the Cambridge Municipal Court.



Units was dispatched to the area of Bennett Ave at Morton Ave, to check on a unresponsive male lying in the grass next to the Dyke.

Upon arrival I observed the male lying on the hill side on his back. The male looked to be disoriented and of need of medical attention. I made contact with the male who was later identified as John M. Young. Young came towards me in a aggressive manner holding a bamboo stick. I ordered Young to put the Bamboo stick down multiple time which he refused. At this time Young raised the Bamboo stick in the air and did attempt to strike me with it.

At this time Young was taken to the ground and did actively fight. Young struck me in the rib area after being taken to the ground. Young continued to try to kick at me. I rolled Young over onto his stomach and at this time [REDACTED] arrived. Young still continued to fight with officers and continued to resist.

Officers delt several knee sticks to Young's rib cage and several open palm strikes to his head. Young refused to give up his hands to officers. Young was advised that he would be tazed if he did not quit resisting. Young continued to resist and was drive stunned. At this time Young complied with officers and he was taken into custody.

Young was check and cleared by United Ambulance after being Drive Stunned.

Young was transported to the county jail were he was charged with Assault on officers, Obstructing and also Resisting Arrest. He was given a court date of 3-13-2015 at 1:00 p.m.

The Bamboo stick was booked into evidence in locker #4.

While on patrol units were dispatched to the area of Morton Ave near Bennett in reference to an unresponsive male laying out on the dyke. Upon arrival Ptl Eubanks was the first officer on scene. Upon my arrival I exited my cruiser and started walking towards Ptl Eubanks and the male, later identified as John M Young. It was at this time that I observed Young make an aggressive movement towards Ptl Eubanks and raise his bamboo stick in the air in the attempt to strike him.

At this time Ptl Eubanks tackled Young and took him to the ground. Upon my arrival Ptl Eubanks and Young were fighting in which I observed Young strike Ptl. Eubanks in the ribs multiple times. I jumped on top of Young in an attempt to place him into custody. Young refused to comply with officers orders to stop and continued to fight. Young was dealt multiple knee strikes to the ribs and palm strikes to the face. I was able to gain control of one of Young's hands but Young buried his other hand underneath his body. At this time I advised Young to give us his other hand or he would be tazed in which he refused to comply. I drive stunned Young one time with my tazer in which it freed up Young's other hand. At this time officers were able to placed Young into custody.

Young was cleared by United Ambulance and was transported to the Guernsey County Jail. Young is being charged with Assault, Resisting Arrest, and Obstructing. Young has a court date set for 3/13/15 at 1:00PM at the Cambridge Municipal Court.

Dispatched to 227 N 5th St Apt C in reference to a male prying on the door trying to break into the residence. Dispatch advised that the male was approximately 6ft tall wearing a black hoodie, jeans and a beanie and is currently inside of the residence. Upon arrival I observed the window next to the porch was broken. As I approached the door I observed blood on the outside of the door frame. I knocked on the door and advised myself as the Cambridge Police. At this time Josh Teeple answered the door and was placed into custody. Teeple was wearing a black hoodie, beanie, and jeans, matching the description of the male breaking into the residence. Teeple also had a cut on his right hand on one of his fingers and was bleeding. Officers found blood on the window sill as well as the frame of the door. During the pat down of Teeple officers discovered a large knife in his pocket as well as a clear plastic tube containing approximately 24 blue pills identified as clonazepam. Josh Teeple advised that Rochelle Pence lives at the residence and that he has permission to be there. Josh Teeple did admit to officers that he attempted to get in the residence through the window but the window broke. Teeple advised that he used a key to get into the residence but he did not have any key in his possession.

Dispatch called Wal Mart and confirmed the story. They did wish to pursue charges against the male if we located him.

Myself and [REDACTED] were dispatched to the area. Dispatch kept Tabitha on the line while we were in route. The male was reported to have on a blue striped shirt, jeans and a hat. While in route it was reported that the male got into the passengers side of a Gold Suburban. Tabitha reported that the vehicle was driving around the lot. She gave the plate as 901-XKB. Once on scene Tabitha reported that the vehicle was now parked and the male whom she followed from Wal Mart was now walking towards Dollar Tree.

[REDACTED] entered the lot from the north entrance and I entered from the south. Once into the lot, I observed the described male walking away from a Silver Suburban, towards Dollar Tree. I saw that [REDACTED] was a few isles from the male and advised him the same on the radio. [REDACTED] stopped by the male and started to get out. At this point the male took off running through the lot, between Dollar Tree and K-Mart, towards the back lot. [REDACTED] was pursuing on foot and I caught up with my vehicle. I cut off the subjects path and he was taken to the ground by [REDACTED]. The male was secured and placed in the rear of a cruiser.

When the male, now identified as Joshua Stevenson, was taken to the ground by [REDACTED] he struck his head on the pavement, causing a cut on his left eyebrow. I examined the cut and thought it my need stitches. I advised [REDACTED] to transport him to jail and get the jailers opinion.

Meanwhile I returned to the Suburban. It was unoccupied. The front windows were rolled down and there were no keys in the ignition. The plate returned to a Judith Hatfield out of Adamsville.

I then spoke to Tabitha at the scene. She stated that when she walked into Wal Mart she saw the male, Stevenson, standing inside with a cart full. She advised that he sounded weird and looked suspicious. She continued on into the store and when she came back out, she saw him riding the cart full of stuff across the parking lot with a Wal Mart employee chasing him. She also saw several employees waiting and came to the conclusion that the male had stolen the items. She then saw the employee with the cart and the male took off over the hill. She started to watch and follow the male, while calling the police.

Dispatch located a number for the owner of the Suburban and tried to call. There was no answer, so she left a message.

I was advised by [REDACTED] that the jail requested that Stevenson be medically cleared before they would accept him. [REDACTED] transported him to the emergency room.

Ptl. Calvert was at Wal Mart and reported that the items that Stevenson stole exceeded \$1000.00. He got a receipt for the items, which was added to the case.

I went to Wal Mart a short time later and spoke with Joseph Adamik, supervisor at Wal Mart. He stated that he was on break, eating inside Subway with a couple other employees. He stated one of the girls stated he is gonna push out. He looked up and saw a male, Stevenson, pull his hat down and start running out of the store with a cart full of merchandise. He stated that an associate, Matt, ran after him to get the pate number from the car. Joseph did give a description of Stevenson.

I then spoke to Matt Sanders, the associate who chased him out of the store. He stated that he heard someone say there was a push out. He turned around and saw someone pushing a cart out. He ran after him. He chased him all the way to the front of the lot, where he ditched the car and went over the hill.



Dispatched to the Days Inn on Southgate in reference to a fight. Upon arrival hotel employees advised that the male is being restrained on the ground. I identified the parties involved as Brandon Roach and Corey Blizard. Blizard was on top of Roach trying to restrain him on the ground. At this time the parties were separated.

Blizard advised that they were drinking when he went out to his vehicle to get some things to bring inside for work in the morning. Blizard advised that his co-worker Brandon Roach approached him and started throwing punches. Blizard advised that he took Roach to the ground and tried to get him to stop fighting in which Roach proceeded to attempt to strike him. Blizard advised that the scuffle continued into the lobby of the hotel when his boss helped him restrain Roach on the ground until the police arrived.

I spoke with a very intoxicated Brandon Roach. Roach's left eye was swollen shut and I observed blood on his hands. Roach advised that he was drinking in the bar when he was attacked by Blizard. Roach was very intoxicated and became very belligerent. I advised Roach numerous times to calm down and be quiet in which he proceeded to yell and scream obscenities at Blizard and his boss. Due to Roach's disruptive behavior I attempted to escort Roach out the door. Once to the door Roach proceeded to pull away and turn towards officers. At this time Roach was taken to the ground. Once on the ground Roach actively resisted officers attempts to be placed into cuffs by trying to push officers off and not giving officers his hands. Once in handcuffs Roach was placed up against a police cruiser to be patted down by Ptl Eubanks. Roach pushed off of the police cruiser and attempted to turn face to face with Ptl Eubanks to try to spit on him. Roach was pushed to the ground to restrain him from spitting on officers. Roach was then placed in the back of the police cruiser. Once in the police cruiser United Ambulance arrived to check on Roach's eye.

I spoke to a witness James Hamilton. Hamilton advised he was outside when Roach and Blizard started to fight. Hamilton advised that he recorded the incident on his phone. On the video I observed Blizard at his truck when Roach attempted to strike him. At this time Blizard takes Roach to the ground and restrains him. Once on the ground Blizard attempts to let Roach go in which Roach grabs Blizard by the head and punches him in the face. Hamilton advised that the fight continued into the lobby when Roach jumped on Blizard's back. Hamilton advised that Blizard threw Roach on the ground and then restrained him until police arrived.

Brandon Roach was transported to SEORMC for treatment. Once medically cleared Roach was transported to the Guernsey County Jail. Roach is being charged with disorderly conduct and resisting arrest. Roach is to appear on 8-21-15 at 8:30am at the Cambridge Municipal Court.

Dispatched to the Speedway Gas Station on E Wheeling in reference to an accident that occurred in the parking lot. Upon arrival I spoke to two witnesses Bruce Borha and Michael Fall. Borha advised that he was pumping gas when he observed a truck take off at a high rate of speed through the parking lot when the truck struck a car. Borha advised that the driver of the truck slammed on the breaks in which the truck slid 15-20 feet, leaving skid marks on the asphalt. Borha advised that he walked over to see if everyone was okay when the two men, identified as Austin Decker and Brian Decker, started yelling at him to "get the fuck out of here, you punk bitch." Borha advised that the male in the green shirt, identified as Brian Decker, stated that "he was not afraid to go back to prison and he would start shooting people." Borha advised that the mother of the two males showed up and started yelling and cussing at everyone stating that "the cops cant do shit."

Spoke to Michael Fall. Fall advised he was sitting in his truck waiting for his co-worker to pump gas when he observed a Ford Ranger flying through the parking lot in front of his truck. Fall advised that the car came to a stop but the Ford Ranger was traveling too fast and struck the car. Fall advised that the two men, identified as Austin Decker and Brian Decker, became very irate, and stated they were going to shoot people and they were not afraid to go to prison. Fall advised that the people in the car were very scared and wanted to leave because they thought the males had a gun.

I spoke to a very scared and frightened Teresa Hamlin. Hamlin was a passenger in the car involved in the crash. Hamlin advised that the two males, identified as Austin Decker and Brian Decker, became very irate. Hamlin advised that the male in the green shirt, identified as Brian Decker, stated that he was going to shoot everyone.

Ptl Eubanks went inside of the Speedway Gas Station and observed video of the accident. Ptl Eubanks advised that you can clearly see the Ford Ranger traveling at a high rate of speed through the parking lot before striking the car.

I approached Brian Decker and advised him to place his hands behind his back and that he was being arrested for menacing. Once in handcuffs I advised Brian Decker to walk to my cruiser in which he replied "im not going fucking anywhere" and refused to follow my order. At this time I escorted Brian Decker towards my cruiser. During the escort Brian Decker pulled away from me and turned towards me in a threatening manner. I was unaware of Brian Decker's intentions and took his demeanor as an attempt to possibly spit on me or do harm. Brian Decker was taken to the ground and then placed into the back of the police cruiser.

Pictures from the accident were documented by camera. Statements were taken by video as well as paper.

Brian Decker was transported to the Guernsey County Jail. Brian Decker was charged with menacing, obstructing, and resisting arrest. Brian Decker is to appear at the Cambridge Municipal Court on 10/13/15 at 8:30am.

Austin Decker was cited for reckless operation and has a court date set for 10-13-15 at 8:30 am.

I then approached Holt and stated that if he did not stop using those profane words in the presence of the neighbors and go inside he would be arrested. He was advised should one more curse word come out of his mouth he would be arrested.

Tevin then turned and began to go inside, however, turned and again used profane language.

I then arrested Holt for disorderly conduct.

While arresting Holt several individuals came out of the home and began to shout at officers. Several of the individuals began to use profane and derogatory language toward the officers for arresting Holt. Several of the individuals were warned to get back or they would be arrested and several did not comply. Individuals of the home continued to come outside and shout at officers and were warned to stay back.

Officers were eventually able to calm everyone down and get them back into the home.

Holt was transported to the Guernsey County Jail and in route advised he had a small bag of marijuana in his pocket.

The bag of marijuana was taken from Holt inside the jail and due to him disclosing it no felony charges will be pursued.

Holt was charged with disorderly conduct by language and will appear in court December 8th, 2015 at 08:30am.

In the fall my body camera was turned off.

We were also keeping an eye on the crowd that had gathered in the front yard. The officers were finally able to gain control of Tristen and escorted him to the car.

I was dispatched to the listed address in reference to a loud music complaint. Upon arrival, [REDACTED] and myself were met outside by Tristen Scott. Scott was visibly upset at the presence of Police officers and inquired as to why we were there.

I explained to Scott we were dispatched to the residence because of loud music. Scott did state that it was his birthday party so there was music but they were not doing anything wrong. I informed him that we still had to investigate the noise complaint and that I needed to talk to Tevin Holt, because Holt was the one that actually lived at the residence.

We walked onto the porch and Scott was still upset with officers and continued to demand to know why we were there and why we were messing with his birthday party. I once again told him I needed to talk to Tevin and advised to him to quit acting the way he was acting.

I knocked on the door and Tevin came out onto the porch and I advised him as to why we were there, and that the music needed to be turned down, and to not make us come back a second time for a noise complaint. We then cleared the scene.

While walking back to our cruisers, dispatch advised that there was a possible domestic situation at 226 N 8th St, which is next to Holt's residence.

We went to the upstairs apartment to investigate the domestic dispute and after speaking with the occupants of the apartment, we determined there was no domestic altercation taking place.

As officers were clearing from 226 Nth 8th, we could hear yelling coming from the front yard of Holt's residence. All units then proceeded back to Holt's to see what the disturbance was. Ptl. Baker was speaking with Holt and advised him that if he continued to use foul language in the presence of his neighbors, he would be taken to jail. Holt turned to walk in the house and started to use foul language while walking. Ptl. Baker then went onto the porch and took Holt into custody.

All of the occupants of the house had come out by this point and were becoming upset that Holt was being arrested. Tristen Scott had become especially upset about Holt's arrest and started acting aggressively toward officers.

Sgt. Peoples was trying to calm Scott down. Scott told Sgt. Peoples to take him to jail, and Sgt. Peoples advised him that he did not want to do that. Scott then tried to walk past Sgt. Peoples, toward where Ptl. Baker was and Sgt. Peoples grabbed his hands and told him he would be going to jail. At that point Scott tried to get away from him by backing away from him. Myself, Ptl. Calvert and Ptl. Miller then grabbed Scott and tried to take him into custody.

Scott was actively resisting and refusing to put his hands behind his back, and actively being combative with us. During the scuffle with Scott, I was punched in the left temple by Scott, knocking me backwards. [REDACTED] and Ptl. Calvert then tackled Scott to the ground where he continued to fight with officers and resist and refuse to give us his hands. While fighting with Scott on the ground I struck him in the shoulder with my flashlight in an effort to get him to quit fighting us and comply with our commands. He finally complied and we were able to get him into custody. We then walked him back to our cruiser and tried to place him in the back seat. He would not willingly get into the cruiser, and continued to physically resist. Ptl. Calvert had to pull him from behind from the driver side while I pushed him in.

Scott was transported to the County jail and charged with Disorderly Conduct and Resisting arrest. He was given a Court date of December 8th at 8:30 A.M.

While serving Scott with his charges in the jail, Scott admitted to punching me while he was resisting and apologized for hitting me. I advised Scott that I would not be pursuing charges for him assaulting me at this time.

While on patrol I ran license plate number, GSW9069, on a white Buick Rendezvous. The registration on the vehicle, GSW9069, was registered on a 2003 black Buick. Officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle on Southgate Pkwy near Turner Ave.

On approach to the vehicle, the right rear passenger later identified as Clifton Oneal Hamilton, opened up the door and took off running north bound on Southgate heading towards Wheeling Ave. Officers gave chase and, after multiple commands to stop, Ptl Eubanks deployed his tazer in an attempt stop Hamilton from continuing. The taser, which made contact with Hamilton, failed to take Hamilton down as he was struck with only one probe in waist line. At this time I was able to catch up to Hamilton and was able to tackle him into the landscaping of Huntington Bank. While on the ground Hamilton resisted arrest and failed to comply with officers orders and refused to give officers his hands. Hamilton had to be delivered several handstikes and knees to bring him into compliance and force him into handcuffs. He was then stood up and after being searched was placed into a patrol cruiser for the duration of the investigation.

Officers traced the route that Hamilton took during the foot chase and discovered a torn plastic baggie. After a more thorough search of the area officers discovered a plastic bag containing a substantial amount of suspected crack cocaine laying underneath a bush. The bush was located in the landscaping where Hamilton was taken to the ground. The suspected crack cocaine was taken as evidence.

Officers re-approached the vehicle and identified the driver as Jessica Blasenbauer, front seat passenger as Kendal Renee Pugliano, and rear left passenger as Ashlei Francis. I looked into the open door of the vehicle where Clifton Oneal Hamilton was seated and discovered a crack pipe lying on the right rear passenger floor board. All occupants were removed from the vehicle, patted down for weapons and secured in separate police cruisers while officers conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle.

During the search of the vehicle, Ptl. Ryan located a makeup bag under the front passenger seat where Kendal Renee Pugliano was seated. Inside of the makeup bag officers discovered a crack pipe containing chore boy and multiple pill bottles containing a variety of pills. No other contraband was located inside of the vehicle.

Jessica Blasenbauer and Ashlei Francis were released and free to leave.

Hamilton and Pugliano were transported to the Guernsey County Jail.

Hamilton was transported to SEORMC to be medically cleared due to a cut on his head.

Pugliano was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia, and possession of a dangerous drug. She has a court date set for 6/28/16 at 8:30AM at the Cambridge Municipal Court.

Hamilton was charged with obstructing, resisting arrest, and possession of drug paraphernalia. Clifton Oneal Hamilton was also served with 4 child support capias, as well as a felony warrant on indictment for obstructing and possession of cocaine. Clifton Oneal Hamilton has a court date set for 6/28/16 at 8:30AM at the Cambridge Municipal Court.

The investigation will be handed over to the detective bureau for possible felony charges against Clifton Oneal Hamilton and Kendal Renee Pugliano.

All evidence was packaged for BCI, booked, and placed into locker 4.

As soon as I exited my police cruiser, one of the involved males took off running north on N5th St. Ptl. Baker and I chased the male north on N5th St for approximately 4 blocks, advising the male multiple times to stop. This report is in reference to the recent use of force involved in case # [REDACTED]. On the evening of June 8th 2017 at 23:31, Officers [REDACTED] and Baker came into contact with James Rodney Price.

During a Terry Frisk of Price, Price indicated to Ptl [REDACTED] that he (Price) had a knife on him. [REDACTED] then advised Price that he was going to remove it and when he did Price turned toward [REDACTED]. When Price did so he grabbed [REDACTED]'s left arm and [REDACTED] took him to the ground. There was a short struggle but Price was quickly taken into compliance by the officers. I was unable to speak with the officers involved in the incident due to my being off but I was able to review the video which goes along with the report.

During an interview with Price he stated that he was attempting to "ditch" drugs in his pocket and that he didn't even turn when the officer punched him in the face. He stated that he only grabbed the officer by reaction to the punch. The Body Cam video showed that Price's statement of facts was untruthful.

After review of this case I found no wrong doing of the officers and found that they reacted within policy guidelines. I find that there is no reason for further inquiry into this case.

While on patrol officers were traveling eastbound on Jefferson Avenue. While traveling we came to be behind a truck traveling well below the posted speed limit. The truck was traveling below 10 miles per hour and came to a near stop at the intersection of South 6th and Jefferson, where there is not posted stop sign. The vehicle then proceeded forward to the intersection of North 7th Street and Jefferson Avenue where it sat for an excessive amount of time before continuing through. Price was asked to step up on the sidewalk in order to remove him from the road and incoming traffic. At this time I went up to the driver side of the vehicle and began to speak with the passenger, Janet Katherine Hardway. Hardway stated that they had come from West Virginia to pick up two individuals, however, did not know who they were.

At this point I heard ██████████ tell Price to not turn on him as he was attempting to pat him down.

I continued to speak with Hardway and asked her if this behavior was normal for Price. She stated that his eyes and behavior are all how he normally acts and it was at this time I observed Price turn around as ██████████ was attempting to pat him down. He reached up and grabbed the left wrist of ██████████ and was subsequently taken to the ground.

I went around the truck and attempted to assist in placing handcuffs on Price, however, he tucked his hands under his body and flailed violently preventing us from taking him into custody. After several seconds his hands were pried from under his body and placed into handcuffs.

During a search incident to arrest Price told officers he did have "crank" inside his pocket.

During my search of Price I located a small metal container that had inside a small plastic baggie with a white crystal substance consistent with methamphetamine.

Price was then placed into a patrol car for the duration of the investigation.

The female, Hardway was briefly detained and then released from the scene.

The vehicle was towed by AM&A towing due to the fact it was parked in the roadway and Hardway did not have a valid license.

Price was transported to the Guernsey County Jail and placed on a felony hold.

For officer safety I advised James Rodney Price to place his hands on his head so I could conduct a pat down. I asked James Rodney Price if he had anything in his pocket in which he advised he had a knife.

I started to conduct my pat down on James Rodney Price, starting with the right side of his body. When my hand started to pass his waist on his right side, James Rodney Price would tense up and lean over to his right. I asked James Rodney Price what he had in his right pocket in which he replied, "a cock ring, and a knife." I advised James Rodney Price that I was going to remove his knife from his pocket. Dispatch advised that Deshaun Jeffrey is at 227 A N 9th St breaking items inside of the residence and flipping out. Dispatch advised that the caller, Teena Gravely his mother, stated that he was outside at the current time. Upon my arrival I made contact with Teena on the front porch of the residence. She stated that Deshaun had locked her out of the residence and refused to let her in. Teena advised as she asked to let her in to get a blanket for her daughter he refused to open the door and wrote out a note that stated "going to hell and killing myself". We then made entry on the residence and located Deshaun upstairs in his bedroom. Deshaun was physically upset.

Deshaun came out of the bedroom and Sgt. Wolfe checked him for weapons. We then took Deshaun outside and Sgt. Wolfe spoke with him. I spoke with Teena and she had stated that Deshaun came home earlier and stated that he had got into a fight with a 16yr old but no charges were being filed. She then stated that he was talking with some female on the phone and he became upset. He stated that he was going to kill the baby in her belly. Teena then attempted to calm him down and he started to break pictures inside of the residence. She then advised that she went to the neighbors house to call the police.

Teena also stated that Deshaun is having a hard time adjusting to the medication change that he is going through. I asked her the location of the note that he had wrote. She had stated that she was unsure of where it had went and pointed to a notebook stating that is what he wrote it in. As we flipped through the pages the note was located. United Ambulance was summoned to the scene. Upon their arrival he refused to go to the hospital. We then took him into custody to be pink slipped for a mental evaluation.

Sgt Wolfe advised to go fill out the pink slip. I then returned to the police station.

Dispatched to 227 A N9th St in reference to Deshaun Jeffrey flipping out inside of the residence and breaking items. Upon arrival officers met the complainant, Teena Gravely, on the front porch of the residence.

Teena Gravely advised that her son, Deshaun Jeffrey, was upstairs and came downstairs upset, and he started to break items inside of the residence. Teena Gravely advised that she left the residence and went to the neighbors, and when she came back to the residence she was locked out. Teena Gravely advised that her son, Deshaun Jeffrey, had written a note that stated he was going to hell and was going to kill himself.

At this time officers forced entry into the residence by breaking a glass pane out of the window and unlocking the door. Officers located Deshaun Jeffrey upstairs inside of his bedroom. Deshaun Jeffrey appeared to be very upset and was lying on the floor. Deshaun Jeffrey was patted down for weapons and brought outside of the residence to speak with officers.

Once outside Deshaun Jeffrey advised that he was upset because his girlfriend had just broke up with him. Officers also located the note that stated he was going to hell and was going to kill himself. Deshaun Jeffrey advised that he was not suicidal and that he did not want to kill himself.

Deena Gravely advised that Deshaun Jeffrey had just had his medication switched and it was effecting him negatively and that she felt he needed to be evaluated.

United Ambulance was dispatched to the scene to transport Deshaun Jeffrey to be evaluated. Officers believed that with the suicide note and his unstable mental state that it would be best for him to be evaluated by a medical professional.

United Ambulance arrived on scene and advised that they would not transport Deshaun Jeffrey because of his past combative actions. Officers advised United that they would transport Deshaun Jeffrey to SEORMC.

At this time officers advised Deshaun Jeffrey to stand up and go willingly with officers to the hospital. Deshaun Jeffrey advised multiple times that he was not going with us and they we would have to fight him. Officers gave Deshaun Jeffrey multiple commands to stand up and comply and go willingly. At this time I grabbed Deshaun Jeffrey by the arm and made him stand up, place his hands behind his back, and he was secured in handcuffs.

Officers escorted Deshaun Jeffrey to the police cruiser that was parked down the street. While walking to the cruiser, Deshaun Jeffrey stopped multiple times and stated he "was not fucking going," and failed to walk with officers. Deshaun Jeffrey was forced to walk to the police cruiser. Once at the police cruiser, Deshaun Jeffrey failed to comply with officers commands, and did not want to get into the back of the police car. Once again Deshaun Jeffrey started to yell that he was not fucking going. I advised Deshaun Jeffrey that if he did not comply and get in the back of the car I would be forced to put him in the car. At this time Deshaun Jeffrey spit saliva from his mouth in my face, and right eye. I grabbed hold of Deshaun Jeffrey and implemented a femoral strike with my right knee, allowing officers to get Deshaun Jeffrey into the back of the car.

At this time I walked back to the United Ambulance and decontaminated my face and head area from where I had been spat on.

Deshaun Jeffrey was pink slipped and transported to Genesis Hospital in Zanesville for medical evaluation.

This report will be passed onto the detective bureau for further investigation.

I reviewed the following incident where force was used:

The incident took place on 10/20/17 at 2059 PM in the vacant apartments of 129 N 6th St. Officers responded to the residence in reference to people being in the vacant apartment on the south side of the structure. Officers observed movement behind the curtains upstairs but it wasn't until a neighbor, who was in contact with the supervisor of the property, advised that the entire building was supposed to be vacant. Officers made entry in to the residence and cleared the downstairs but were unable to move upstairs because it was barricaded by a couch. While inside officers outside advised that they saw people attempting to exit out of the upstairs windows. Officers then backed out of the residence and secured it until GCSO and Post units arrived on scene. Once a perimeter was established with the additional units, officers made entry into the upstairs and conducted a search with K-9 Drago. Tony Hackley came out advising he was surrendering but he wouldn't comply with officer's orders and when he was pulled to the ground he attempted to conceal his hands. Officers used appropriate body strikes to effect the arrest while continuously giving him verbal commands to comply. Once he was taken into custody officers continued to clear the upstairs apartments. When officers encountered the others inside officers only had to pull them to the ground to take them into custody. Those subjects were using passive, uncooperative resistance and once they were brought to their bellies they were taken into custody without incident.

Upon review of the case I found no reason for any further action to be taken in this incident. Officers conducted themselves within the standards of the policy. Officers used the force necessary to effect the arrest on a suspect who was actively pulling away from them and attempting to conceal his hands underneath himself and in his pockets.

On 10/20/2017 at approx. 2059 hrs we were investigating a breaking and entering at 129 N. 6th ST. We observed individuals in the residence and verified that it was supposed to be vacant. The suspects failed to obey commands to exit the residence. The property owner was contacted and gave permission to force entry into the residence.

Upon entry the stairs had been blocked with a couch. PTL [REDACTED] moved the couch and PTL Smith announced that a K9 would be released if the occupants didn't present themselves. When no response was received K9 Drago was sent into the apartment. As Drago reached the top of the stairs Hackley emerged with his hands up. Hackley was given commands to get on the floor and when he failed to do so PTL [REDACTED] took him to the ground.

I went to assist PTL [REDACTED] with Hackley and saw that he had was digging in the pockets of his sweatshirt. I gave him commands to show his hands and place them behind his back. After he failed to follow my commands twice and continued to dig in his pockets I delivered a hammer fist with my right hand to the left side of his torso. I grabbed his left arm while I was positioned behind him as he was laying on his right side. When I grabbed his arm he attempted to pull away and dig in his pocket more. I started to deliver knee strikes with my right knee to his upper back. The entire time I continued to give commands to show his hands and place them behind his back. His arms finally came free and I was able to force them behind his back and place him in handcuffs.

Officers were dispatched to 129 N 6th St. after the complainant, Charles Brown called and advised that there were two males and a female entering the vacant residence. Upon arrival, Ptl. Ryan and Plt. Harper went to the back of the residence, while I went to the front. While waiting for other units to arrive, I observed an individual open the curtains and peek out of the front window briefly. Sgt. Wolfe and Plt. [REDACTED] arrived moments later and helped cordon off the house to prevent anyone from escaping. Ptl. Ryan advised over the radio that he could see people looking out of the second floor windows, and at one point a male came out of a window and was on the roof of the house before going back inside through a window. He also advised that the back door to the residence was open, as well as a window on the North side of the house. A short time later I observed a Male with bald head wearing jeans and a black shirt start to come out of one of the front second story windows, once he saw me he went back into the residence. Dispatch contacted the Realtor, Teresa White, who had the property listed and White advised that no one was supposed to be inside of the residence. She contacted the Home owner who gave permission for us to force entry into the house.

Once the Sheriff's Deputies and a Trooper arrived to help secure the perimeter of the house, Sgt. Wolfe, Patrolman's [REDACTED], Ryan and I along with Plt. Smith and his K9 approached the house. The stairway leading to the second floor of the residence had been barricaded with a couch that had been pushed down the stairs. The couch was cleared out of the way and Plt. Smith announced our presence and advised anyone inside to show themselves. No one came forward so the K9 was released and we started our search of the Home. Once we reached the top of the stairs a Male, identified as Anthony Hackley showed himself with his hands raised. He failed to follow commands to lay on the floor. Officers forcefully took him to the floor where he continued to struggle with officers and wouldn't show us his hands, which he kept underneath of him by his waist band. After a brief struggle he was secured in cuffs.

We continued to search the residence and located Amy Thompson hiding in the closet of the bathroom. She was taken into custody at that time. A quick secondary search of the residence was then conducted and Gary Burkett Jr. was found hiding underneath the kitchen sink in the cabinets. He was taken into custody. All three were transported to the County Jail and placed on a felony hold. All vidmic data will be uploaded to the case file. This case will be forwarded to the Detective Bureau or the filing of possible felony charges.

On 10/20/2017 at approx. 2059 hrs we were investigating a breaking and entering at 129 N. 6th ST. We observed individuals in the residence and verified that it was supposed to be vacant. The suspects failed to obey commands to exit the residence. The property owner was contacted and gave permission to force entry into the residence.

Upon entry the stairs had been blocked with a couch. PTL [REDACTED] moved the couch and PTL Smith announced that a K9 would be released if the occupants didn't present themselves. When no response was received K9 Drago was sent into the apartment. As Drago reached the top of the stairs Hackley emerged with his hands up. Hackley was given commands to get on the floor and when he failed to do so PTL [REDACTED] took him to the ground. I went to assist PTL [REDACTED] with Hackley and saw that he had been digging in the pockets of his sweatshirt. I gave him commands to show his hands and place them behind his back. After he failed to follow my commands twice and continued to dig in his pockets I delivered a hammer fist with my right hand to the left side of his torso. I grabbed his left arm while I was positioned behind him as he was laying on his right side. When I grabbed his arm he attempted to pull away and dig in his pocket more. I started to deliver knee strikes with my right knee to his upper back. The entire time I continued to give commands to show his hands and place them behind his back. His arms finally came free and I was able to force them behind his back and place him in handcuffs.

I have reviewed the use of force report submitted by [REDACTED] from an incident that took place in the Tiki lounge at the Southgate hotel. Officers were called to a medical emergency where United requested officers to assist with an intoxicated female. While officers were out assisting United, a male later identified as Joshua Eltringham, became belligerent and subsequently was arrested. Mr. Eltringham attempted to push past Ptl. Castor while the medics were tending to the female and [REDACTED] and Ptl. Castor took Mr. Eltringham to the ground where he was handcuffed. Once the officers brought Mr. Eltringham into compliance no other force was used.

After reading the report and viewing the video, I find that [REDACTED] and Ptl. Castor used only the amount of force that was necessary at the time of the arrest and no further action is needed.

At this time Joshua said to me "You need to get the fuck off of me" while pointing his finger at me. I advised to Joshua that he needed to calm down. Joshua was then transported to my cruiser and patted down for weapons in which none were found. Joshua was placed in the back seat of my cruiser and transported to the Guernsey County Jail. Upon arrival to the jail, I removed Joshua from the back of my cruiser and asked him if he had anything on him that I may have missed while patting him down, and if he did and took it in to the jail, he would be charged with a felony 3 conveyance charge.
