By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$30.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the permission to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes, only, a small island in the east end of Tract No. 13, Coventry Township, Summit County, Ohio, and being approximately near the center of East Reservoir.
