You have submitted for my examination a written petition signed by one hundred qualified electors of this state containing a proposed constitutional amendment and a summary of the same under the provisions of Section 4785-175, General Code. It is proposed to amend the Constitution by adding to Article XV thereof twenty-two new sections (i.e., Section 9-a to Section 9-v, inclusive).
