Narrative:

On Sunday, May 12, 2024, at approximately 1645 hours, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested to investigate an officer involved critical incident, involving personnel from the Euclid Police Department, the Cleveland Heights Police Department, and the Elyria Police Department. The incident occurred at 16100 Van Aken Boulevard, Shaker Heights, Ohio 44120.

BCI Assistant Superintendent Mark Kollar coordinated BCI's investigative efforts and communicated with other law enforcement agencies on scene.
