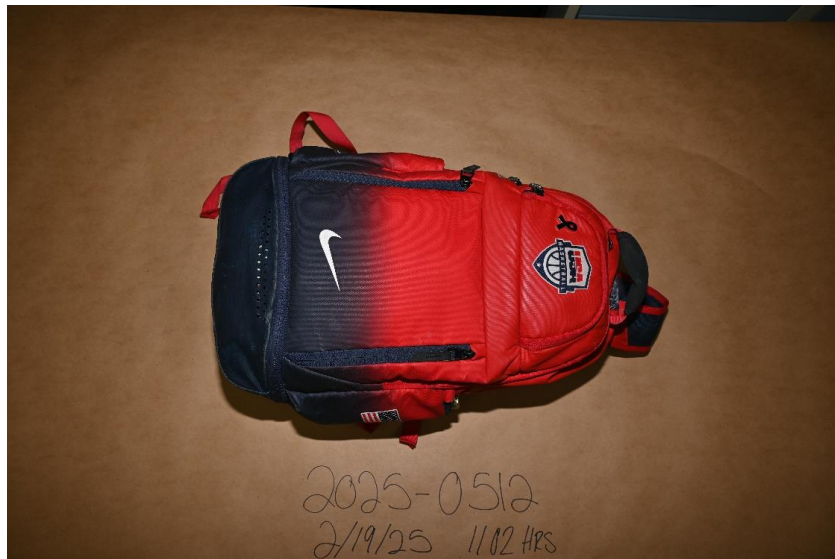


Figure 1: Evidence Item #20

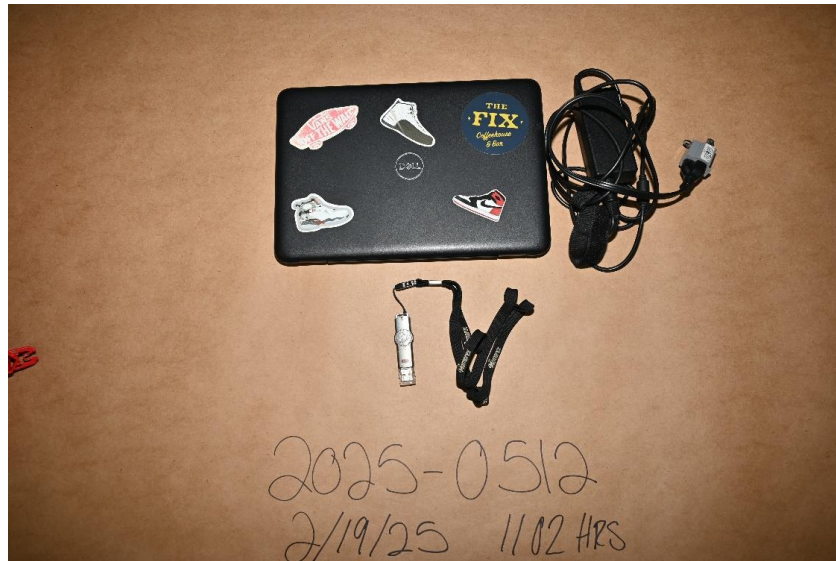


Figure 2: Evidence Item #26 and #27
