Narrative:

On Tuesday, March 28, 2023, at 1425 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran (Moran) received an email from Brookfield Township Police Department (BTPD) Sergeant (Sgt.) Aaron Kasiewicz (Kasiewicz). The email contained a copy of BTPD incident report number 23-001415 documenting the report of a stolen vehicle.

SA Moran reviewed the report and noted the following:

Narrative Supplement: BTPD Officer (Ofc.) Nicholas Leonardo (Leonardo) responded to the address and met with the victim, William Shafer (Shafer), who reported that someone stole his 1996 Chevrolet truck between 1730 hours and 2100 hours on that date. The Chevrolet truck had a yellow colored Myers snow plow on the front of it. Shafer said there was a set of keys inside the vehicle. Shafer told Ofc. Leonardo that he knew about the vehicle pursuit that occurred in Trumbull County earlier that day and he believed that the subject in the pursuit was the person who stole his truck.

Later that evening, BTPD Sgt. contacted Ofc. Leonardo by phone about the vehicle pursuit that occurred earlier that day in Trumbull County. Sgt. said he spoke with the property owner (Brian Adkins) and that the subject from the vehicle pursuit was in a cabin on the property with a vehicle that matched the description of Shafer's stolen truck. Sgt. told

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Ofc. Leonardo that he would provide him with more information when the subject was in custody.

Ofc. Leonardo learned about the incident that occurred through news stories on March 21, 2023. Ofc. Leonardo later determined that the Chevrolet truck recovered at the incident scene was Shafer's truck.

A copy of the BTPD incident report was attached to this report. Please refer to that report for additional details.

On the above date and approximate time, I was dispatched to the above address in reference to a vehicle theft. Upon arrival, I was met by the victim, William Shafer. Shafer advised that sometime between the hours of 1730 and 2100, one of his vehicles was stolen.

I asked Shafer if he has had anyone show interest in obtaining the vehicle recently. Shafer advised no. I proceeded to have Shafer give me a description of the vehicle. Shafer advised that the vehicle was a blue and grey 1996 Chevy GMT-400 (Sidestep). Shafer went on to describe the vehicle as having a yellow Myers plow blade on the front. Shafer advised that the vehicle just recently had four brand new tires put on it. Shafer then advised that there was a big crease on the tailgate from backing into the corner of a garage. Shafer also advised that the rear bumper was almost rotted out, and that the rear license plate was being held on by some type of wire. Shafer added, inside the pocket on the driver's door, was a red strap. Shafer also mentioned that there was a green strap on the passenger seat of the vehicle. Further description of the vehicle was that there were gloves and a beanie cap on the dashboard, the ashtray was broken and laying on the floor of the interior of the vehicle, it had a broken glove box, both rockers on the vehicle were in terrible condition, the truck had a sliding rear window and finally, there was a large crack that went almost the entire length of the windshield.

After obtaining a very in-depth description of the vehicle, Shafer advised that there was a set of keys in the vehicle, but did not know the exact location in which they were located. Shafer advised that he heard about the pursuit that occurred earlier in the day, and had a strong feeling that the individual involved in the pursuit stole his vehicle. I advised Shafer that it was possible, but I would be looking into all avenues. I advised Shafer that I will keep him updated with my findings in this case.

After I had Shafer fill out a motor vehicle theft affidavit, I cleared scene.
