improvement bonds in the aggregate amount of \$600.00, dated November 1, 1939, and bearing interest at the rate of 4% per annum.

From this examination, in the light of the law under authority of which the above bonds have been authorized, I am of the opinion that bonds issued under said proceedings constitute valid and legal obligations of said school district.
