Narrative:

On Thursday, December 19, 2024, at 1400 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb (SA Holcomb) and SA Aja Chung (SA Chung) interviewed Kim Wilson (Wilson), relative to the officer-involved critical incident which took place on Thursday, December 19, 2024. The interview took place at her place of employment, Doyle HCM, located at 735 Taylor Road, Gahanna, Ohio. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information about the incident known or observed by this individual.

Wilson stated that she is a data analyst for Doyle HCM.

Wilson said that she was on the second floor, corner office, of the building in a meeting with the blinds closed. A co-worker then noted something occurring outside which then drew everyone's attention.

Wilson then opened the blinds and saw a police officer coming through the parking lot with a gun drawn. She then saw the subject walking and noticed additional cops following the subject with their guns also drawn. She believes the subject was wearing a white shirt and maybe shorts. He was heavier set and looked "like a kid."

The subject was "just walking" eastbound through the parking lot. She then noticed a small black gun in his right hand. He always kept the firearm down to his side. She saw the subject turn back towards the cops, but he never raised the firearm. Wilson said it was like he was just ignoring all the commands law enforcement was yelling.

Wilson said she couldn't hear what the cops were yelling but, "... it looked like they were yelling at him to drop it." The subject just kept walking and eventually crossed Taylor Road (northbound). He then went behind bushes and police officers continued to follow him. Shortly after he went behind the bushes, the shooting occurred.

Wilson believes she heard around seven (7) to eight (8) gunshots.

Wilson said that numerous police cruisers had their emergency lights activated. SA Holcomb asked Wilson if she believed the police officers were well identified as law enforcement officers. She replied with, "Oh yeah."

Wilson stated that she did not take any photos or videos of the incident.

The interview concluded at approximately 1406 hours.
