Narrative:

On Monday, September 11, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Kyle Douglass received training and personnel file records from Blendon Township Police Department (BTPD) Administrative Assistant Allana Penry (AA Penry) for BTPD Officer Connor Grubb (Officer Grubb). BCI Special Agent Jenny Comisford (SA Comisford) reviewed the training and personnel file records and noted the following:

Use of Force History

Prior to the incident on August 24, 2023, Officer Grubb had approximately 15 reported uses of force. The earliest use of force incident was dated August 28, 2019 and the most recent was July 2, 2023. The three earliest uses of force dated August 28, 2019, February 29, 2020, and June 19, 2020 were documented on a BTPD "Action – Response Supplement" form, and no reference to a supervisory review was noted. The remaining uses of force were documented on a BTPD "Use of Force Report" form, all of which were deemed "Within Policy."

Disciplinary

Prior to the incident on August 24, 2023, Officer Grubb had two records of documented corrective counseling:

- Requirement to Take Action, Suicide & Suicide Attempt Response Procedures, dated March 16, 2019
- Standards of Conduct/Attendance, dated May 28, 2023

Per a "Final Disposition" letter dated April 11, 2019 from BTPD Chief John Belford, it was determined that any complaint against Officer Grubb as a result of the incident that occurred on March 16, 2019 was determined to be "Unfounded." It was noted Officer Grubb would not be disciplined for any violation of policy as he was in a field training status and under the direct supervision of his field training officer.

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 3:33 pm, you and two other Blendon Township Police Officers were on-duty and in performance of your official duties when you were dispatched to the scene of a possible suicide attempt at 2980 Morse Road, in Blendon Township, Franklin County, Ohio. The subject and subject vehicle were not found at this location. Information available to you at the time led you to investigate a possible secondary scene at 3322 Morse Road in an attempt to locate the reported suicidal subject. You and the two other Officers located the subject vehicle at this secondary location.

Neither you, nor either of the two other Blendon Township Officers, got out of your cruiser(s) to check the interior of the subject vehicle for the subject, or for any possible items or evidence which might have indicated if the subject was in the vehicle, or if any items or evidence indicated if the subject was still in the area or may return to the vehicle, or to determine if he was still armed with the reported gasoline and lighter. You did not get out of your cruiser to check to see if the cell phone that was being "pinged" was in the vehicle or search to see if the phone, or if any other relevant evidence was nearby. Further, you were the first Officer on the scene and you reported to your fellow Officers, who arrived later, that the vehicle was "unoccupied", when you had not checked thoroughly enough to have made that determination.

This is in violation of the Blendon Township Police Department Manual of Directives, Section 2.A.008, 5.C.049 & 5.C.050.

You are hereby reprimanded for this sub-standard duty performance.

This Letter of Reprimand will remain in your personnel file for one year from the date of issuance provided there is no same or similar conduct during the aforementioned one-year period of time.

Summary: On March 16 2019 @ 1529 Columbus police received a 911 call from an individual who stated he tried to commit suicide. The dispatcher asked where he was at. The caller stated that he was at uhaul on Morse road near Cleveland Ave. The caller stated that he just tried to commit suicide and needed help right now. The caller stated that he just tried to set himself on fire. The dispatcher asked the caller if he had already lite himself on fire. The caller stated yes, he poured gas on himself and lite it. The caller then stated that he is in a 2016 burgundy Denali. The dispatcher asked him what his name was, and he stated Grady. Grady then told the dispatcher that everything is going on and everything has caved in on him. Grady then stated that he needed someone right now. The dispatcher stated that she was sending help and asked if he was alone. Grady stated yes and that he did not want to hurt anyone else. Grady then stated that he would be ok until someone got to him, said thanks and hung up.

Columbus Police transferred the call to Franklin county. Columbus Police told FCSO that a male was at Uhaul at 2980 Morse road in a burgundy GMC Denali. The male had doused himself in gasoline and wants to set himself on fire and has a lighter on him. The male wasn't going to do anything until officers got there and he says he cannot take it anymore. The males name is Brady and he disconnected before anymore information could be given. At 15:33 FCSO toned the call out as a priority one suicide attempt. Officers and deputies were sent to 2980 Morse Rd by dispatch. The first officer on scene was FCSO car 22 at 15:34. Blendon officer Dewart arrived in the area at 1538 and officer Grubb and Flynn arrived at 1539. After checking the parking lot of Uhaul at 2980 Morse Road and speaking with customers, no GMC denali was found and no one had seen one. Dispatch advised that they did a cell phone ping and it was pinging in the area of 3450 Morse Road and it was within .24 miles of that tower. Officers and deputies continued to check the area during the ping. Blendon Township officer Dewart was then advised to check the Uhaul at 3322 Morse Road at 15:49 and arrived at 15:52. Officer Dewart found a burgundy GMC denali in the rear of 3322 near the storage units. Officer Dewart advised that she found the vehicle and Officer Flynn and Grubb responded. Officers then stated that the GMC denali was unoccupied and continued to search the area. At 16:17 Blendon Township officers cleared the whole call unfounded (C/C).

On March 17 @ 1649 Blendon Township officer Flynn and Dewart were dispatched to 3324 Morse Road on a missing person. When officer's arrived, Columbus Police was on scene and had crime scene tape up. Blendon Township officers were told that Columbus Police was looking for Grady because they had entered him as a missing person. Officers were checking the area because his onstar was showing in the area. Columbus officers found Grady sitting in the driver seat of his Yukon with burns on his face, pants and the interior of the Yukon. The scene was given to Blendon Township Police because it was in their jurisdiction. Detective Retherford was called to the scene to process. Westerville Fire investigators were called as well to investigate the fire. Preliminary findings show that Grady committed suicide by fire and carbon monoxide from the fire. The body was handed over to the coroners office and the Yukon Denali was impounded to Shamrock Towing.

Sgt. Moynihan and Officer Grubb did the death notification to the family. The family stated that Grady attempted suicide in 2015 and in 2017. Grady owed over a million dollars in back taxes and could not pay his employees on Friday because he did not have the money.

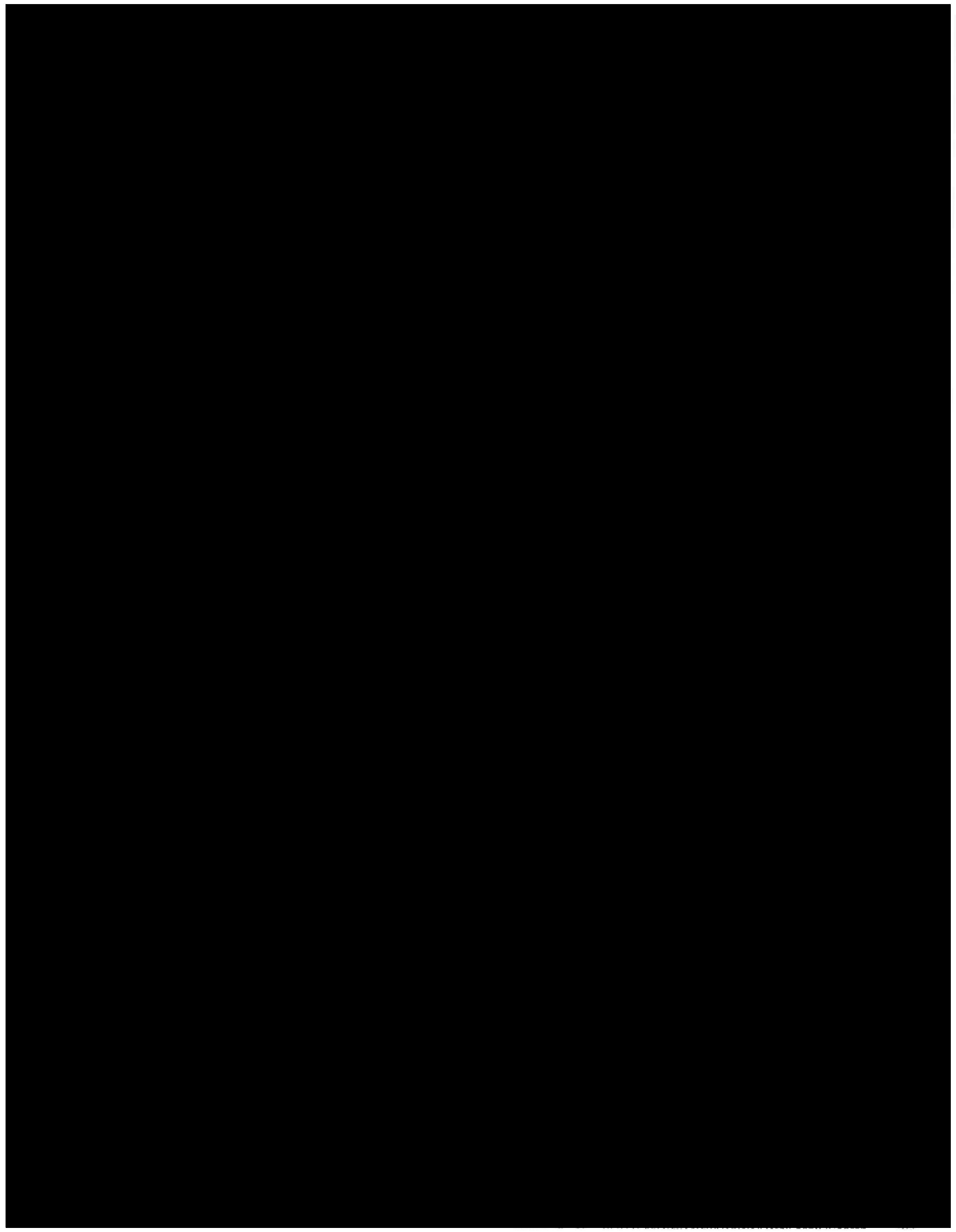

Narrative

On 03-16-19 at approximately 4:00pm Officer T. Baughn #2738 was dispatched to the area of Craigmere Ct / Ramsdell Pl at the request of Franklin County Sheriffs Office to check on the report of a suicidal subject threatening to douse himself in gasoline and light himself on fire (190207115). Officers and the CPD Chopper checked the area surrounding those streets for the subjects 2016 Maroon GMC Yukon, but did not locate him. Officers Baughn and Marshall also checked the address of 5440 Flathead Ct to check for the subject. No one was at the address and the subjects car was not at scene or in the garage either. County cars also checked areas close by in their jurisdiction.

Several hours later Officer Baughn was dispatched to the 5440 Flathead Ct address to complete a missing persons report on the subject. The caller/wife stated that the subject had checked himself into hospitals in the past when he felt like this. Officer Baughn requested the Comm Channel to contact local hospitals to see if the subject was in their care. None of the hospitals had the male and a cell phone ping showed the phone in the area of French Park Dr / Westerville Rd. Several officers again searched the area for the subject and his vehicle, but were unable to locate him. Officer Baughn spoke to Det. Garrett with Missing Persons and then Det. Smith with DV unit who stated to complete the Missing Person's report and not treat the run as a High-Risk Missing Person.

The subject's cell phone was pinged earlier around 4:00pm by CPD and FCSO and then turned off (190207115). Officer Baughn requested another ping on the phone during the Missing Persons report at approximately 8:30pm (190207653). The other call on the subject which was duplicated was (190207118).



Officers were dispatched the area of Brewstir's following a call of a possibly impaired driver that fled the scene of a crash. As I pulled into the rear lot of Brewstir's I saw a male matching the given description except he was wearing faded blue jeans, which could have been mistaken for grey, talking on the phone in the lot. Upon seeing me the man turned and entered the patio area of the bar. I pulled up by the rear door of the bar and as I entered, I could see the man running out the front door of the bar. The man was wearing a black jacket with white lettering on the back. I ran back outside and alerted Officers Vickers and Grubb. By the time I ran south and around to the courtyard I had lost sight of the man. Officer Vickers headed back to the Suspect's vehicle to secure and impound it as Officer Grubb and I checked the area for the suspect. I parked and walked through Kroger and noticed a man with similar styled hair as the man who ran, but wearing a bright blue hoodie, talking on the phone and carrying a loaf of bread. The man did not make eye contact with me as he passed and turned toward the self-checkout. I turned to follow him and when I rounded the corner he was gone. A patron told me the man in the blue sweatshirt had thrown his bread on top of the water machine and ran out the side door. I radioed Officer Grubb and we continued working south through the complex checking businesses. Officer Grubb radioed stating the subject may have crossed Executive Pkwy toward Goodyear. I found Officer Grubb and we walked across Executive Pkwy at the same time, as he explained a patron informed him a man wearing blue had run that way. Officer Grubb checked between Goodyear and McDonalds and I checked between Goodyear and the Car/Pet wash.

Officers Grubb and Ricker made their way down the sidewalk toward the area of 6108 Batavia Rd and observed a thin white male standing on the sidewalk and talking on the phone. As Officers Grubb and Ricker approached the male, Zachary Kuchler came out of the house to see what was going on. Officer Ricker told Zachary to stay where he was and show his hands. Officer Grubb approached up the driveway to get a better view of Zachary, who the caller stated was going to go get a gun. Zachary was wearing a baggy sweatshirt, so Officer Grubb ordered him to the ground at gunpoint. Officer Grubb kept his gun pointed at Zachary as Officer Ricker approached and told him to put his hands behind his back. Officer Grubb approached as well once Officer Ricker began securing Zachary in handcuffs. Officer Grubb holstered his firearm and instructed Zachary to cross his legs at his ankles. Officer Grubb controlled Zachary’s legs while Officer Ricker placed two pairs of handcuffs on Zachary due to his large build, gapped and double locked. Officers Grubb and Ricker then did a quick pat down for weapons and found that Zachary was unarmed. Officer Bigler who arrived on scene, stayed with Zachary while Officers Ricker and Grubb conducted a brief investigation into the events that occurred. Following the investigation, the situation was found to be a misunderstanding, with both Zachary and the alleged victim telling the same story. On 11/28/2020 at approximately 2230, Sgt Moynihan and Officer Grubb of the Blendon Twp. Police department, responded to a domestic complaint at 6241 S Sunbury Rd (BP). The dispatcher stated that a male and female were arguing at the Firestone at 6136 S Sunbury road. Description for the male was a male black named Steve, dark hoodie, and dark pants. The caller stated that the male half has a knife and had possibly used it on the female either early that night or just before the time of call. The female half left the scene and called at 6241 S Sunbury Rd. Sgt Moynihan arrived on scene at the BP and talked to the female half, who stated that the male half is still at the Firestone. Officer Grubb found the male half in the parking lot of Firestone. Officer Grubb put the subject in handcuffs for an investigative detention. Officer Grubb had double checked the cuffs for not being tight, and double locked them on the subject. The subject's name is Steve R Merritt DOB; 04/12/1974. Shortly after, Officer Moeller of Blendon Twp. Police, arrived on scene at the BP with Sgt Moynihan. Officer Forren and Sgt Smith of Minerva Park Police Department arrived to assist Officer Grubb at Firestone. Sgt Moynihan and Officer Moeller discovered that the female half had been stabbed in the right elbow. A medic was called for the female. Officer Moeller left the scene at BP to inform Officer Grubb at Firestone. Sgt Moynihan through his investigation at the BP, found that incident occurred at the Firestone, and requested the Columbus Police Department (CPD) come and handle the investigation. Officer Grubb, Moeller, Forren, Sgt Smith, and later Sgt Newman held the scene until CPD arrived. Mr. Merritt While holding the scene, Mr. Merritt attempted too defecate in the back of Officer Grubb's vehicle, and kicked the doors. The subject was pulled out of the vehicle and was seated on the curb in the parking lot. While seated on the curb, the subject showed racial prejudice against the officer, by stating that they are "racist mother fuckers, and stupid white cops." Mr. Merritt numerous times attempted to stand up against officer's commands. While seated on the ground, Mr. Merritt pulled down his underwear, exposing his buttock, to attempt to defecate in front of the officer's. After Sgt. Newman had help Mr. Merritt put his pants back on, Officer Moeller and Sgt Smith, escorted Mr. Merritt to car six. While escorting Mr. Merritt to car six, Mr. Merritt repeatedly pushed and pulled to Officer Moeller, all while forcefully asking to suck Officer Moeller's dick and forcefully moving towards Officer Moeller's genitals. Here Officer Moeller, and Sgt Smith used verbal commands to stop, and use balance displacements, as well as joint manipulations. Officer Moeller, and Sgt. Smith put Mr. Merritt into the back of car 6 with out any injuries. Mr. Merritt while in the back of car six, once again attempted to defecate, and kick the doors of the car. Mr. Merritt was pulled out of car six and seated again on the curb. Mr. Merritt attempted numerous times again to stand up to urinate in the parking lot. Mr. Merritt while laying on the ground, and against officer's commands, pulled out his genitals, and proceeded to urinate on the parking lot and roll around in his urine. Sgt. Smith and Newman stood Mr. Merritt up, and Mr. Merritt attempted to pee on the Sergeants. Mr. Merritt as well attempted to defecate in the direction of Sgt. Smith. Sgt Smith, and Newman escorted back to car six, while using balance displacements, and joint manipulation. Once at car six, Mr. Merritt began pulling away from the sergeants, and refused to move by using dead weight. Officer's attempted to get Mr. Merritt into the back of car six, they tried lifting him into the vehicle. Mr. Merritt dove headfirst into the vehicle, on his own will, and landed his head on the seatbelt buckles. Mr. Merritt complained that his eye hurt, and a medic was requested. While waiting on a medic, Columbus Police Department arrived to process the scene, and take custody of Mr. Merritt. The medics arrived on scene and cleared Mr. Merritt of any injuries. The scene was then left to Columbus for handling.





DETAILED NARRATIVE – Include any Officer-Subject Factors and/or Special Circumstances -- SEE MANUAL OF DIRECTIVES APPENDIX II (Attach a Continuation Sheet if Needed): On 06-19-2020 at approximately 1808, Officers were dispatched to 3507 Manila Dr on a male that was suicidal and in the basement with a gun. The male was a known party, Andrew Kelley (Defendant). The defendant's partner stated that he was severely intoxicated and stated that he was going to kill himself with his gun. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the family of the defendant inside the house. The family stated that he was in the basement with the gun. Officers cleared the family out from the house, then called down to the defendant. The defendant kept asking who was at the top of the stairs. Officer's Grubb and Cardi identified themselves as Police Officers with the Blendon Township Police Department and called for him to come to the top of the stairs without the gun. The defendant came to the top of the stairs and became agitated when he realized the Police were on scene. Officers Grubb and Cardi told him to place his hands behind his back and that he was being detained. The defendant did not want to be detained and pulled away, tensing his arms up. The Officers grabbed his arms as he continued to try and pull away, and struggled with the defendant to put cuffs on him. The Officers finally got the defendant in cuffs as he became more and more agitated. Officer Grubb took the defendant toward the front door in order to secure the defendant in his cruiser. Officer Grubb detected the obvious odor of alcoholic beverage coming from the defendant. Officer Grubb approached the door with the defendant while Officer Cardi went to the basement to secure the firearm. While Officer Grubb was approaching the front door, the defendant lifted his hands up from behind his back to his left side and grabbed a hold of Officer Grubb's service pistol. The defendant then tugged on Officer Grubb's handgun in an attempt to get it from the holster. Officer Grubb placed his elbow in the defendant's back and pushed him toward the ground in order to prevent the defendant from gaining control of his firearm. Officer Grubb landed on top of the defendant and placed his right knee in the gap between the defendant's left arm and his torso in order to keep him on the floor until help arrived. Officer Willis then came in the door and helped Officer Grubb pick the defendant up off the floor in order to proceed to his cruiser. The defendant began bleeding from a cut above his eye. While outside, the defendant started screaming obscenities in the presence of the neighbors. Officers Grubb and Willis opened the back of the cruiser and asked the defendant to get in. The defendant refused. Officers Grubb and Willis then attempted to place the defendant in the back of Officer Grubb's cruiser by turning him to face away from the cruiser to take a seat, and the defendant began to struggle physically with the Officers. The defendant used his legs to leverage himself off the cruiser to prevent from being assisted in. The defendant also pushed with his body weight against Officer Grubb while Officer Willis went around the other side and pulled on the defendant while Officer Grubb pushed, and they were able to get him in the cruiser laying across the seat. Westerville Fire Department Medic 112 arrived to check the defendant's injuries. The defendant refused medical attention from the Fire Department and proceeded to smash his head against the inside divider in Officer Grubb's cruiser. Officer Grubb and Deputy Severance placed leg shackles on the defendant because the defendant was kicking the inside door of the cruiser as well. Officer Grubb then transported the defendant to Riverside Methodist Hospital and admitted him to the emergency room on a pink slip psychiatric hold for evaluation.

On 02-29-2020 at approximately 1902, Officers were dispatched to a non-injury crash at SR161EB at Strawberry Farms Blvd. Officer Grubb arrived on scene first, and parked behind the two cars that were in the turn lane from SR161EB to turn onto Buenos Aires Blvd, both blocking the intersection. Officer Grubb got out of his cruiser and made contact with the two individuals who were arguing with each other about who hit who. The individual that was determined to be at fault was identified as Miguel Delgado (Defendant). Officer Grubb told the defendant and the other driver wait a second while he got his winter hat from his car. While Officer Grubb was inside his cruiser, the defendant got back in his car. Officer Grubb noticed the defendant's car that he was parked behind begin to roll back, so Officer Grubb got out of his cruiser and approached the driver door. Officer Grubb opened the driver door and told the defendant to put the car in park. The car was still rolling back toward Officer Grubb's cruiser, and Officer Grubb ordered the defendant to put the car in park again. The defendant finally got the car in park just before it hit the front of Officer Grubb's cruiser.

Officer Grubb told the defendant to get out of the vehicle, and he did not. The defendant began arguing with Officer Grubb about who was at fault in the accident, so Officer Grubb ordered the defendant to get out of the car. The defendant did not get out of the car, so Officer Grubb grabbed ahold of the defendant and pulled him out of the car. As Officer Grubb pulled the defendant out of the car, the defendant went straight to the ground. Officer Grubb got on top of the defendant in order to place the defendant in handcuffs. Officer Grubb ordered the defendant to place his hands behind his back in order to cuff him but the defendant refused, Officer Grubb called for additional units, as he struggled with the defendant to place him in handcuffs. Officer Grubb was able to gain control of the defendant's arms and place the defendant in handcuffs as Officer Cardi arrived on scene. Officer Grubb stood the defendant up and placed him in the back of his cruiser. The defendant told Officer Grubb that he had diabetes, so Officer Grubb called for a medic in order to make sure the defendant wasn't suffering from a diabetic episode. Westerville Medic 112 arrived on scene and checked the defendant's blood sugar. The medics stated that his blood sugar was fine and determined that he did not need transported at that time. Officers then moved all the vehicles out of the roadway down into Ridgewood Park at 5450 Buenos Aires Blvd, clearing the intersection for traffic.

After conducting a brief investigation into the possibility of OVI, it was determined that the defendant could be suffering from a medical emergency other than diabetes, and medics were called to the park. The defendant was highly disoriented and unable to provide basic information about himself or his family. The defendant was then transported to St. Ann's Hospital by Westerville Medics and admitted to the emergency room.

On 08-28-2019, Blendon Twp Officer's were listening to the Westerville PD channel when they heard of a suicidal subject that had left multiple suicide notes at his home, and had texted his parents indicating he was going to kill himself. The subject's name was aired as Ali Hyajneh (Defendant), and that he was approximately 5-7 and 320Lbs, and his parents had told Westerville Police that he likes to go up to Hoover Reservoir. With this information, the Blendon Twp Officers went up to Hoover to check for the defendants vehicle. Officer Nance located the vehicle in question in the main lot of Hoover Dam, and radioed the vehicle location. Officer's Grubb and Ricker then arrived on scene with two Westerville Officers. Officer's Grubb and Ricker then pulled up a picture of the defendant on their computers, briefly studied it, and then headed out onto the dam in order to locate the defendant. The two Westerville Officers on scene and Officer Nance then set out onto the dam as well in order to help locate the defendant. As Officers Grubb and Ricker approached the center of the dam, Officer Grubb noticed a subject that matched the description of the defendant on the south side railing of the dam, leaning and looking back toward the officers repeatedly. Officers Grubb and Ricker then stepped aside and pointed the defendant out to the Westerville Officers who were the original responding Officers. The two Westerville Officers and the three Blendon Twp Officers then approached the defendant together. When the Officers got close to the defendant he stepped out into the middle of the dam, and asked if the Officers had tracked him with his license. Westerville Police Officer Dickison then told the defendant to take a seat for his safety. The defendant stated that he would stand, and Officer Dickison grabbed hold of the defendants left arm in order to assist him to the ground to prevent him from jumping. The defendant tensed up and attempted to pull away from Officer Dickison. The rest of the Officers then surrounded the defendant and attempted to get him on the ground. Officer Grubb got behind the defendant and conducted a leg sweep, bringing the defendant to the ground. Once on the ground, the defendant rolled onto his stomach, and pulled his arms in tight underneath him. Officer Grubb attempted to pull his left arm out from underneath him as Officer Dickison attempted to dry stun the defendant with his Taser as a pain compliance technique in order to gain compliance from the defendant, however this had no effect as the defendant was wearing a thick jacket. Officer Grubb struck the defendant in the back multiple times in order to gain compliance via large muscle group pain compliance. during the course of attempting basic pain compliance techniques, the defendant gained control over a Westerville Police Taser, and deployed it at Officer Grubb. The prongs did not hit Officer Grubb, who observed the Taser wires fly past his face and into the air. Officer Grubb then pulled his Taser out in response to the subject that had control over a Taser, and deployed his Taser into the back of the defendant. The defendant yelped, however did not discontinue his active resistance. Officer Grubb then placed the Taser on the back of the defendants upper left leg, and the defendant immediately stopped resisting, and stated multiple times that he was done and would comply. Officer Grubb holstered his Taser, and Officers Ricker and Nance got the defendant cuffed. The defendant was then transported stable with minor injuries to St. Ann's by Westerville Medic 113.

The subject was thus detained in handcuffs, during which he pulled away from officers, who were able to gain control and successfully secure the subject. The handcuffs were properly gapped and double locked. The subject however began to complain about the handcuffs being too tight. Officer Moeller double checked the handcuffs and was able to fit two fingers between the subject's wrists and the cuffs. The subject complained of being injured from the handcuffs throughout the duration of the contact until released.

While attempting to take the individual into custody for a psychiatric pink slip, the subject said she wasn't getting pink slipped again, turned, and took off up the stairs. Officer Grubb and Sergeant Moynihan stopped her by grabbing her arms. Officer Grubb had the subject's right arm, Sgt. Moynihan had the subject's left arm. Kirsten was sitting near the top of the stairs and was instructed to head outside. She refused to move. Officer Grubb got the subject's arm behind her back and tried pushing her toward the door but she would not budge. Officer Grubb then placed his knee behind the subject, between her shoulder blades and applied pressure to get her moving down the stairs. Combined with Sergeant Moynihan pulling on her left arm, the subject was moved down the stairs. At the front door, the subject was pulling away from officers and refusing to move. She was thus placed in handcuffs by Officer Grubb, which were properly gapped and double locked. She was then taken out of the house and placed in the back of Officer Grubb's cruiser until Deputy Jenkins arrived to transport her for a pink slip to OSU.

On 01-10-2023, officers responded to a suicide attempt at the listed address. Officers arrived to find Lauren Wagner, a 17yo female bi-racial, with a cut on her wrist. Lauren surrendered the knife after some persistence from Officers Grubb and Rees. Lauren made suicidal statements about wanting to die, so it was determined she needed pink slipped. Lauren however, refused to cooperate with the officers. Officer Grubb told Lauren to get up and she did not, so Officer Grubb grabbed her left arm and pulled her up. Officers Rees, Clark, and Deputy Jenkins each grabbed another limb, and all pulled Lauren off the bed and sat her on the ground. She was sitting on the ground when Officers Rees, and Clark got her in handcuffs assisted by Officer Grubb. Two pairs of handcuffs were used, and each were gapped and double locked. Lauren was then taken outside and put in Deputy Jenkins's cruiser before being transported to Children's Hospital on a pink slip.

On 12-08-2022, officers were dispatched to a domestic violence incident with a possible kidnapping where the caller's boyfriend left her mothers house on foot with their 7 month old son in a baby carrier. The caller said her son's father was cutting through yards and headed back to Edgeway Dr. where he lived. Officer Grubb arrived in the area of Montevideo Rd and Caracas Dr and spotted a male walking on foot West on Caracas with a baby carrier. Officer Grubb pulled up next to him, exited his cruiser, and told the subject to stop. The subject stopped and Officer Grubb told him to put the baby carrier down and that he was being detained. The subject did not put the carrier down and Officer Grubb grabbed the handle to secure the child. After tugging on the carrier handle briefly, Officer Grubb was able to get the kid from the subject and placed the carrier on the ground behind him. Officer Grubb then grabbed the subjects left arm to place him in handcuffs but the subject pulled away and Officer Grubb grabbed him by his jacket front to keep him close. Officer Grubb then stepped in front of the subject with his right leg, grabbed the subject by the back of his jacket, and executed a leg sweep, off-balancing the subject and getting him to the ground on his back. Officer Grubb immediately jumped on top of the subject, placing his weight on the subject's torso, and grabbed the subjects right wrist. Officer Grubb rolled the subject to his stomach, and got the subject handcuffed as Sgt. Moynihan arrived. The subject was issued a summons for obstructing official business and released.

While processing an unrelated scene at the Martahon gas station, Officer Grubb observed a male fleeing on a bicycle south on SR3 being pursued two Columbus cruisers with lights and sirens activated. Officer Grubb drew his firearm and pointed it at the fleeing subject who did not stop after being ordered to by Officer Grubb. Officer Grubb then put his shoulder into the subject as he was passing Officer Grubb, knocking him off the bicycle. The suspect caught himself and was attempting to get away so Officer Grubb grabbed him around the neck and sat down on the ground with his gun still in his right hand. Officer Grubb holstered his firearm as he held the suspect around the neck in a loose headlock in order to keep him secure and away from his firearm. Officers Moeller and Bingham almost immediately put hands on the suspect, with Officer Moeller controlling the suspects left wrist, and Officer Bingham controlling the suspects right arm. Sgt. Moynihan controlled the suspects legs and brought the suspects legs to his rear end while crossed in order to control his lower half. The two involved Columbus Officers, Leach and Wilson then placed the subject in handcuffs while he was being restrained on the ground. The subject did not report any injuries from the incident. Officer Grubb did have a slight abrasion to his left forearm from the pavement.

After being called to the scene of a mental health episode on the side of SR161 at I270S, Officers arrived on scene and saw the subject being held down to the ground by several citizens that had stopped on the side of the road to assist. Officers Grubb and Cardi took over for two of the citizens, only one remained and was stabilizing the subject's head. Officer Grubb held the subjects' legs down while Officer Cardi maintained control of the subject's hands by holding the wrists. The subject was attempting to bite and scratch anyone he could during this time, and had both kicked and punched those involved in restraining him multiple times throughout the course of the incident. Westerville medics with Medic 112 administered a nasal spray medication to calm the subject down. Once the subject calmed down a little, he was moved to the gurney and strapped in. He was then transported to Children's Hospital for evaluation. The subject did not sustain any injuries during the contact with officers, but had a preexisting abrasion to his nose and forehead upon officer arrival.

Brown (Defendant) to require arresting. The defendant was approached by Officers Grubb and Cardi, who informed the defendant that he was being placed under arrest. The defendant had a phone in his right hand at the time, so Officer Grubb grabbed the defendant's right wrist and removed the phone from his hand, then placed it inside his right coat pocket. Officer Cardi was on the left side of the defendant and grabbed his arm to place it behind his back in order to get handcuffs on the defendant. At this time, the defendant sprung forward in an attempt to get away from the officers. Officer Cardi immediately grabbed the defendant around the waist as the defendant fell to the ground while using his arms to try and pull himself away. Officer Cardi tackled the defendant to the ground while Officer Grubb assisted on the right side of the defendant. Both officers were on top of the defendant at this point. Officer Grubb was on the right side and placed the defendant's arm behind his back. Officer Cardi was on the left and got the left hand behind his back. Officer Grubb got his handcuffs out and placed them on the defendant, then properly gapped and double locked them. Officers Grubb and Cardi then had the defendant roll onto his butt, then stood him up. The defendant was walked to cruiser #15 where he was searched incident to arrest and placed in the back of the cruiser.

During the incident, the defendant sustained a laceration to the right wrist area and had a capillary bleed. The defendant refused medical attention after Westerville Medic 113 arrived. Officer Cardi sustained an abrasion to the right forearm that covered an area of about 2in X 3in, and that blood had pooled on. Medic 113 treated Officer Cardi at the scene.

The defendant was transported to FCCCII where he was slated for domestic violence - threats, aggravated menacing, and resisting arrest.

Officers were dispatched to 4246 Executive Parkway regarding domestic violence on the date and time listed. Ravenna L Brown called 911 and told dispatchers her son was on drugs and treating to hurt her.

Officers arrived and spoke with the caller Ravenna Brown said her son Kavon Brown. Kavon asked to use her vehicle, and she said no because he does not have a license Kavon became irate. Instead, an argument broke out, and Kavon started calling her a bitch. Ravenna then called Kavon's probation officer Scott Semonisin who was on speaker and listened to most of the argument. Ravenna said Kavon said he was he would kill her. Ravenna said she was in fear that Kavon would cause harm to her and wrote a witness statement.

Officers called Franklin County probation officer Scott Semanisin for a statement seen below.

I received at 6:58PM today from Mr. Brown's mother, Ravenna Brown

At 6:58PM today (3/21/22), I received a phone call from Ravenna Brown. She told me she wanted her son (Kavon Brown) out of her house. I asked her why and she eventually said he wasn't doing anything, like usual. All he does is play video games or run in the streets. She said he continues to use meth and cocaine and she's tired of it and said he'll never change. At some point, Mr. Brown must've walked into the room because she told him that she was on speaker phone with me. They began to scream at each other and she demanded he leave. The screaming stopped and I heard him say, "Just shut up or I'm going to kill you." She yelled at me, "Did you hear that?!" I said that I did. Then she yelled, presumably to her son, "Don't touch my door... that's my door!" and then I heard why sounded like a screen door slam. She and I continued our conversation and eventually she decided she was going to call the police.

Kavon denied making any threats to Ravenna and said he was on his game system. Officers went to place handcuffs on Kavon, and he tried to run when officers escorted him to the





On 02-06-2022 after responding to a call regarding a dispute at Kroger, Officers made contact with Danusia Babinski (Subject). The manager and loss prevention supervisor wanted the subject to be trespassed after she was yelling at customers inside the store. Officer Grubb walked the subject outside to create distance between her and the witnesses while she explained what happened. Officer Grubb heard her side of the story and told her that if she feels she was wronged by Kroger, that she has the option of filing a complaint with Kroger Corporate. Officer Grubb then told the subject that she was being trespassed from the store. The subject remained extremely argumentative, disputing the grounds for the trespass. Officer Grubb told the subject she needed to leave right now, or she would be arrested for trespassing. The subject shoved her phone right in front of Officer Grubb's face, so he grabbed it out of her hand then promptly returned it to her. The subject exclaimed loudly as if this was some sort of misconduct.

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NARRATIVE CONTINUED:

Officer Grubb then grabbed her under her right arm with his right hand and grabbed her by the jacket on her upper back area in order to turn her around and escort her toward the curb. Once at the curb, Officer Grubb told the subject to leave multiple times or she would be arrested, and she just continued to argue. Officer Grubb then placed her under arrest and grabbed her left wrist in order to get her hands behind her back. Officer Cardi was on the right side at this point and grabbed her right arm to place it behind her back in order to get her in handcuffs. The subject began to pull her arm away from Officer Grubb and tried stepping away. Officer Grubb then placed his right shin against the back of the subject's left calf in order to off balance her while he regained control of her arm and got it behind her back to be handcuffed. The subject was placed in hinge handcuffs that were properly gapped and double locked. The subject was then brought over to the cruisers which were parked in front of the laundromat where she was placed in the back of cruiser 2. Officer Grubb was completing paperwork at the scene when the subject began complaining of wrist pain, so Officer Grubb got out to adjust her cuffs. Officer Grubb loosened the handcuffs which were already of proper gapping, and double locked them. He then told the subject to get back in the cruiser and she did not. Officer Grubb stepped toward her and applied pressure to her shoulder in order to get her back in the car. The area the two were standing on was icy and there was snow on the ground. As a result of the subject not moving her feet to get into the cruiser, she fell over and landed on the seat in the back of the cruiser. Officer Grubb tried to help her back up, but she refused to let him help her. Officer Grubb then offered to call for a medic, but the subject refused. The subject then successfully got in the cruiser once more. At this time there were no visible injuries to the subject's wrists or otherwise.

The subject was then transported to and slated at FCCCII without further incident. During this interaction the subject did complain multiple times of wrist pain in regard to the handcuffs. The wrists were rechecked at the jail but there was no sign of injuries nor redness.

NARRATIVE CONTINUED:

From the parking lot of the Car/Pet wash, I saw the subject laying face up on the grass behind the cellular tower. I radioed to advise Grubb and ran that way, losing sight of the subject momentarily. As I turned the corner, I saw the man now standing up and facing Officer Grubb.

Officer Grubb stated as the man came into view from his perspective, the man was seated on the ground, talking on the phone. Officer Grubb drew and armed his Taser and pointed it at the man, as the man stood up, talking on the phone. Officer Grubb repeatedly ordered him to drop the phone but he failed to comply.

I had not been able to hear any of the conversation/commands due to wind and road noise(from SR 161) and car wash and vacuum noise. It appeared to me that the man was trying to grab something in his pockets as his hands were in front of him. Also, knowing he had been in a position to surrender and had now stood up facing Officer Grubb, I was unsure of his intentions, so I ran up to the man from behind, grabbed both arms hooked by the elbows and pulled them back and to my left, knocking him off balance and telling him to "Lay down! Lay down! All the way down!" and both of us guided him to the ground in the grass. I positioned my weight over his upper thighs, as Officer Grubb straightened his upper body flat on the ground and stabilized his right shoulder/side. The man was secured in handcuffs which were gapped and double-locked immediately. The man was read Miranda and searched for weapons and walked back to Officer Grubb's cruiser.

The man was then identified as Scott Kuhn. Scott admitted he ran because he had warrants. Scott also said he'd taken his jacket off and hidden it inside Kroger. The jacket was recovered hidden in the paper towel aisle.

Scott did not have any visible injuries or request any medical care, nor did he complain of any injury while in custody and was slated without further incident.

There is no available cruiser video or audio for this incident.
