DISAPPROVAL—PROPOSED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SCIETE BENEFICENZA FIORE D'ITALIA (BENEFICIENCE SOCIETY FLOWER OF ITALY).

DEAR SIR: I acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 16, wherewith you enclosed proposed articles of incorporation of Sciete Beneficenza Fiore D'Italia (Beneficence Society Flower of Italy) for my approval.

It appears that the corporation is proposed to be organized as a corporation not for profit under the provisions of the General Corporation Act of Ohio.

Inasmuch as the articles provide for the payment of death benefits to members and since it does not come within the exemptions of Section 9491, General Code, I am of the opinion that it will be necessary to comply with the laws governing the organization of insurance companies.

I am returning herewith the articles of incorporation of the aforementioned company, together with the copy of the constitution and by-laws, without my approval.
