ACTION TAKEN:

When I arrived at the incident location I spoke with Sgt. J. Donahue #1122 and I asked "what did he need me to do?" He stated that I could give Officer Z. McCormick #1498 a break since he was standing outside and getting cold. I relived him at his location which was in front of 328 Ira Ave. Officer McCormick pointed out that there were shell casings in the street as well as one on the trunk of a black Honda Civic, OH plate KLW-3304. Once I relived him I secured the scene until BCI arrived.

BCI made contact with me and asked what evidence was I securing at the scene. I pointed out to the placement of the shell casings and how many I could see and told her I didn't know if there were more on the other side of the car. I continued waiting until said that she was going to photograph the scene. She advised me that I would not have to secure that area anymore because she was taking over.

I went back to my crusier and asked Sgt. Bowman #1400 did he have anything he wanted me to do? He stated that he wanted me to relieve an officer that had to get back in service. I moved my crusier #404 to block the intersection at Lakesore Blvd. and Ira Ave. When I got into position I was given the Crime Scene Log for the west side of the crime scene. While securing my area I had 2 more agents from BCI come in with their trucks and equipment.

I maintained the post until BCI said they were clearing the scene and at that point I removed all the crime scene tape from that intersection and everything going east of Lakeshore Blvd.
