Narrative:

On May 21, 2024, at approximately 1025 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) received a National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) lead notification. This NIBIN lead notification linked a Taurus G2C, 9mm firearm bearing a serial number of ACJ267311, to Cleveland Division of Police Incident # [REDACTED]. The above-mentioned firearm was recovered in the bathroom of 16100 Van Aken Boulevard #301, Shaker Heights, Ohio 44120, as a result of the May 12, 2024, officer involved critical incident. A copy of this NIBIN lead notification was added as Attachments #1-2 to this report. Refer to Attachments #1-2 for further details.

SA Harasimchuk obtained a copy of Cleveland Division of Police Incident # [REDACTED] and noted the following:

This incident report was for a felonious assault that occurred on May 6, 2024, at approximately 2235 hours, at 14106 Glenside Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44110. This report involved the following individuals:

The report stated that officers responded to 14106 Glenside Road for a male, [REDACTED], who had been shot. [REDACTED] had multiple gunshot wounds to various parts of his [REDACTED] s body. Two 9mm cartridge casings and a bullet fragment were recovered on the ground near [REDACTED] s vehicle.

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██████████ was interviewed by the police. Tania stated the following:

While on scene, we spoke with ██████████ (interview). She stated that she is the sister of the victim. She stated that the person whom shot her brother was her child's father, DeShawn Vaughn (suspect). She stated that an incident occurred earlier in the day at her home (12802 Craven Avenue) in which she called her brother for assistance. The details of the incident are outlined in CAD ██████████. She stated that the suspect texted her phone and said "tell your brother that you love him." She stated that shortly after the text message was sent to her phone, she heard multiple gunshots outside and her brother was shot. She stated that the suspect drives a blue Chrysler 200 with a silver front passenger door. She stated that she did not witness the incident but she is confident that her child's father is the person whom shot her brother.

Antonio Santiago (Santiago) was interviewed by the police. Santiago stated the following:

I spoke with Antonio Santiago on scene. He stated that he witnessed the shooting today. He stated that when he backed out of the driveway white 2016 Chrysler 200 (KGZ6741), he noticed a blue Chrysler 200 with the headlights off. He stated that the suspect vehicle was traveling east on Glenside avenue. He stated that he saw the suspect vehicle pull next to the victim's vehicle and someone from inside of the suspect's vehicle began shooting into the silver ford fusion. Mr. Santiago was accompanied in his vehicle by Aubriauna Landingham (witness) whom concurred with the story that Mr. Santiago told us on scene.

██████████ was interviewed by the police. ██████████ stated the following:

We were able to confer with ██████████ at UH hospital. The victim was in the ED inside of room #19. He stated that he went to his vehicle to get his I Pad. He stated that he sat in the driver's seat and noticed a blue Chrysler 200 with a silver door driving eastbound on Glenside Avenue. He stated that he knew that the vehicle belonged to the suspect. He stated that he thought that the suspect was approaching to talk about the incident that happened earlier in the day. He stated that the blue Chrysler 200 with a silver passenger door pull alongside of him and the one occupant inside of the vehicle began shooting. He stated that he felt a bullet hit him so he jumped into the backseat in which he was shot multiple times again. The victim stated that he did not wish to complete a victim's rights packet at this time due to him being in extreme pain.

A search warrant was obtained for a 2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color with a silver front passenger door, bearing an Ohio plate of KGK5770, and a vehicle identification number (VIN) of 1C3CCCAB7GN154289. The following items of evidence were recovered from the vehicle:

A Cleveland Division of Police Detective was assigned to follow up on this incident. As a result of the detective's investigation an arrest warrant was issued for De'Shawn Vaughn. The detective's follow up report also noted the following:

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Shaker Heights, OH

Additional Threats: While issuing the warrant [REDACTED] called stating now De'Shawn is texting her, and is threatening to shoot up her grandfather and grandmothers house. The address of 335 E 211 is in Euclid. I advised her to contact Euclid Police, and reference the previous two reports.

I also conferred with Euclid PD and advised them of the situation.

It should be noted that the location of occurrence for BCI 2024-1472 was at 335 East 211th Street, Euclid, Ohio 44123. Per Cleveland Division of Police Detective Shuan Polocy #1247, the additional threat information was received on May 9, 2024.

A copy of Cleveland Division of Police Incident #2024-124400 was added as Attachment #3 to this report. Refer to Attachment #3 for further details.

On May 28, 2024, at approximately 1601 hours, SA Harasimchuk received a second NIBIN lead notification, related to this investigation. This NIBIN lead notification linked cartridge casings collected from BCI 2024-1472 to the above-mentioned firearm and to Cleveland Division of Police Incident # [REDACTED]. A copy of this NIBIN lead notification was added as Attachments #3 to this report. Refer to Attachments #3 for further details.

On May 29, 2024, at approximately 1330 hours, SA Harasimchuk received an Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) NIBIN lead and link chart related to BCI's NIBIN leads. This NIBIN lead and link chart were added as Attachment #4 to this report. Refer to Attachment #4 for further details.

TO: CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CLEVELAND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND/OR DETECTIVE SHAUN POLOCY, BADGE #1247, A MEMBER OF SAID DEPARTMENT, AND/OR ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AS AUTHORIZED.

WHEREAS there has been filed with me an affidavit, a copy of which is attached hereto, designated as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein as though fully rewritten, wherein Affiant avers that she has probable cause to believe, and does believe, that within a vehicle, more fully described as: **a 2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door, Ohio Plate No. KGK5770 VIN No. 1C3CCCAB7GN154289**, towed from the location of 22046 Wilmore Avenue, Euclid, Ohio on May 09, 2024, which is currently secured at **the City of Cleveland Impound Lot #2, 4300 Bradley Road, City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio**, there is now being kept, concealed, and possessed the following evidence of a criminal offense:


Firearms, ammunition, clothing and/or any and all biological evidence including but not limited to blood, skin, hair or other biological material tending to indicate the vehicle's contact with a person and/or trace evidence tending to indicate a person's contact with the exterior of the vehicle; and/or any evidence tending to establish possession or control of the vehicle such as gunshot residue, fingerprints, personal belongings or other items within the vehicle and/or the appearance of the vehicle to be documented through photographs and/or any other evidence tending to establish a violation of the laws of the State of Ohio, to wit: R.C. 2903.11, Felonious Assault.

I am satisfied that there is probable cause to believe that the property described is being concealed in the above-described vehicle and all containers and compartments located within the vehicle, and that grounds for the issuance of this search warrant exist.

1C3CCCAB7GN154289, towed from the location of 22046 Wilmore Avenue, Euclid, Ohio on May 09, 2024, which is currently secured at the City of Cleveland Impound Lot #2, 4300 Bradley Road, City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio and all containers and compartments located within the vehicle, forthwith within three days of the date herein, for the property specified, making the search in the day season. If the property or any part thereof be found there, you are commanded to seize it, leaving a copy of this warrant and a receipt for the property taken, to prepare a written inventory of the property seized, to return this warrant to the undersigned or any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, and to bring the property found on such search forthwith before said Judge, or some other judge or magistrate of the county having cognizance thereof.

Before me, a Judge of the Cuyahoga Court of Common Pleas, personally appeared the undersigned Detective Shaun Polocy, badge #1247, who being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is a member of the Cleveland Division of Police Department and that his training and experience include the following: over 13 years of experience as a commissioned police officer, of which over 8 years with the Cleveland Division of Police, and currently assigned to the 5th District Detective Bureau as part of the Violent Crime Reduction Team (VCRT). Affiant has been a Detective for over 3 years. Affiant has graduated from the Cleveland Police Academy. Affiant has received training in the investigation of criminal offenses in violation of the laws of the State of Ohio and the laws of the City of Cleveland.

Affiant avers that he has probable cause to believe, and does believe, that within one vehicle, more fully described as: **a 2016 Chrysler 200**, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door, **Ohio Plate No. KGK5770 VIN No. 1C3CCCAB7GN154289**, towed from the location of 22046 Wilmore Avenue, Euclid, Ohio on May 09, 2024, which is currently secured at **the City of Cleveland Impound Lot #2, 4300 Bradley Road, City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio**, there is now being kept, concealed, and possessed the following evidence of a criminal offense:

Firearms, ammunition, clothing and/or any and all biological evidence including but not limited to blood, skin, hair or other biological material tending to indicate the vehicle's contact with a person and/or trace evidence tending to indicate a person's contact with the exterior of the vehicle; and/or any evidence tending to establish possession or control of the vehicle such as gunshot residue, fingerprints, personal belongings or other items within

the vehicle and/or the appearance of the vehicle to be documented through photographs and/or any other evidence tending to establish a violation of the laws of the State of Ohio, to wit: R.C. 2903.11, Felonious Assault.


The facts upon which Affiant bases such beliefs are as follows:

1. Affiant avers that on May 06, 2024 at approx. 10:41 pm officers from the Cleveland Division of Police, 5th District responded to 14106 Glenside Avenue, Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, OH for a report of shots fired and a male victim shot. Officers arrived on scene and located the Victim, identified as [REDACTED], in the rear of a silver 2015 Ford Fusion. Officers discovered [REDACTED] had been shot multiple times and rendered aid. EMS arrived and transported [REDACTED] to University Hospital, main campus for treatment.
2. Affiant avers police investigated the scene and located several suspected bullet holes to the driver side of the Ford Fusion. Officers collected 2 shell casings and a bullet fragment on the ground near the Ford Fusion. Officers conducted a series of witness interviews and developed a timeline of the events leading up to the shooting.
3. Affiant avers on May 06, 2024 at approx. 8:55 pm, officers from the Cleveland Division of Police, 4th District took an aggravated menacing report from [REDACTED], his sister [REDACTED] and their brother D.P. (DOB 06/02/2007). [REDACTED] has a child with a Deshawn Vaughn. According to the 3 siblings, Vaughn was with the 3 siblings, had brandished a firearm, and threatened to shoot them. Vaughn then left the scene in a **2016 Chrysler 200**, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door.
4. Affiant avers that later that evening, [REDACTED] received a text message from Vaughn stating "Tell your brother you love him." Moments later, witnesses observed a **2016 Chrysler 200**, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door drive down Glenside Avenue and discharge a firearm into the Ford Fusion where [REDACTED] was sitting. [REDACTED] stated that there was only one person in the **Chrysler 200**.
5. Affiant avers that [REDACTED] was shot 9 times. 3 bullets were located inside [REDACTED]'s body.
6. Affiant avers that the **2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door** belongs to Vaughn but is in his grandmother's name, Toni Ferguson of Painesville, OH. Officers obtained and reviewed RTCC footage from the incident, and obtained the license plate of the **2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door: KGK5770**. This vehicle is registered to Toni Ferguson of 1055 Brentwood Drive, Painesville, OH. A warrant was issued for this vehicle.
7. Affiant avers on May 09, 2024, officers of Euclid Police Department located a **2016 Chrysler 200**, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door, **Ohio Plate No. KGK5770 VIN No. 1C3CCCAB7GN154289**. This vehicle was processed towed to **the City of Cleveland Impound Lot #2, 4300 Bradley Road, City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio**.
8. Affiant avers based on his training and experience that discharging a firearm inside a vehicle will result in physical evidence of the shots on the interior or exterior of the vehicle, namely: gunshot residue, shell casings, bullet fragments.

9. Affiant avers based on his training and experience that shooting another person will cause blood and tissue to spray in various directions, including in the direction the shots came from. Thus evidence of a shooting could be found in or on the source of the gunshots.
10. Affiant avers that it is necessary to search the above-described **2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color with a silver in color front passenger door** for any and all evidence that will identify the driver and passengers of the vehicle at the time of the above-described shooting, including but not limited to, DNA evidence, gunshot residue, fingerprints, electronic devices, documentation, papers, and clothing.
11. Affiant avers based on the foregoing, he has probable cause to believe, and does believe, that the following evidence of the above-described felonious assault shooting will be found within the above-described **2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color with a silver front passenger door**:

weapons, firearms, shell casings, and/or ammunition; documentation, papers, clothing, personal effects, and/or any items tending to aid in the identification of the person(s) using or having been inside the vehicle; electronic devices including cell phones; the physical appearance of the exterior and interior of the vehicle and all objects therein; biological and forensic evidence including but not limited to gunshot residue, gunshot residue, fingerprints, blood, and biological material from which a DNA profile(s) may be developed, and any evidence tending to establish the violation of R.C. Chapter 2903.11, Felonious Assault.



On 05/06/2024 while I was assigned to the 5th District Detective Bureau, I received the above complaint to investigate. The following are my results:

Synopsis: De'Shawn Vaughn while operating a Chrysler 200, blue in color, with a silver front passenger door, traveled EB on Glenside. De'Shawn turned off his headlights while traveling slowly towards [REDACTED] who was in his vehicle retrieving an I Pad. De'Shawn brandish a firearm, and discharged multiple rounds, striking [REDACTED] several times (along with [REDACTED] vehicle). De'Shawn fled EB.

On Scene: Witnesses Antonio and Aubriauna observed the blue Chrysler 200 with silver door travel EB and discharged a firearm into the Ford Fusion that [REDACTED] was in.

[REDACTED] s sister stated it was her child's father De'Shawn Vaughn. Explained a previous report that occurred two hours prior: 24-124276- 05/06/24 @ 2000hrs, 12802 Craven De'Shawn brandished a handgun and threatened to shoot [REDACTED] and Deandre Perkins. De'Shawn arrived and fled in his Chrysler 200, blue in color, silver front passenger door, and dark tint.

Evidence: (2) 9mm spent shell casings, and (1) bullet fragment.

Phone Interview [REDACTED] I called [REDACTED] and her statement coincided with her initial statement on scene. She re-explained the incident on Craven, and explained De'Shawn has been sending multiple threatening texts. She will send. [REDACTED] believes since they split up on 04/18/24, she is not sure of where he is currently residing. [REDACTED] believes it would either be his aunt's address on Braeburn Park Dr. in Euclid, or at his grandmother's address in Painesville.

[REDACTED] was at UH, so she handed the phone to [REDACTED] His statement coincided with his initial statement in the report. He thought De'Shawn arrived to speak about what occurred only a couple hours prior, and then he began shooting [REDACTED] multiple times. [REDACTED] said after being struck he crawled into the back seat for cover, but was continually being shot.

Chrysler: While speaking with [REDACTED] she explained the vehicle is De'Shawn's vehicle, but it is in his grandmother's name. Tania stated the grandmother is a Toni Ferguson, and lives in Painesville. The door is silver, because De'Shawn had it replaced.

RTCC: I observe the suspect's vehicle travel SB from E 152, WB on St. Clair, and SB on E 141 just before the incident. After the incident I observe the vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed traveling EB on Euclid passing Catalpa, and continues EB on Euclid until leaving our city. Requested RTCC to upload video.

FLOCK: After seeing the RTCC cameras I was able to obtain a plate of KGK5770 on a blue in color Chrysler 200, with a front silver passenger door, and dark tint.

05/06/24 @ 2226hrs E 152 & St. Clair

05/06/24 @ 2236hrs Euclid & London

OHLEG KGK5770: Vehicle comes back to a 2016 Chrysler 200, blue in color, and the listed owner is Toni Ferguson (11/13/57), with an address of 1055 Brentwood Dr.

Painesville Police: I conferred with PPD dispatch to see if Toni had any recent reports of the vehicle being stolen or taken without permission, and PPD has no records of either Toni or De'Shawn making a report or call.

Prosecutor's Office: I conferred with APA Burns, and a warrant has been created for De'Shawn and the Chrysler 200.

***** WARRANT – SUSPECT WANTED *****

Additional Threats: While issuing the warrant [REDACTED] called stating now De'Shawn is texting her, and is threatening to shoot up her grandfather and grandmothers house. The address of 335 E 211 is in Euclid. I advised her to contact Euclid Police, and reference the previous two reports.

I also conferred with Euclid PD and advised them of the situation.

05/08/2024 Phone Interview [REDACTED] She identified herself as the mother of [REDACTED] She explained she was on scene, inside of the home. She heard the shots but did not see anything. [REDACTED] also stated that De'Shawn was making threats to go to the school where Deandre Perkins attends which is Shaw HS. She already notified ECPD. I explained for her to send me the threats when able.

Cameras: RING cameras noticed by officers on scene at 14003 & 14011.

Glenside: I knocked on 14003, 14011, & 14105, got no response left cards. I spoke with a neighbor, Antonio Reed ([REDACTED]), who stated he heard the shots, and when he looked out his window he observed a blue sedan (unsure make/model, though possible Kia) traveling EB with no headlights on.

05/09/2024 Process Tow: Euclid PD located the vehicle in front of 22046 Wilmore Ave. Was processed towed to lot 2 under VIU [REDACTED] Under CAD [REDACTED]

NICE Unit: Advised NICE Unit of De'Shawn for assistance in apprehension.

UH Hospital: [REDACTED] was discharged from UH Main Campus.

05/10/2024 SIU Ford Fusion (VIU 24-7526): (94) photos taken, no latent prints, (2) bullet fragments, (1) sample 2 swabs suspected blood.

05/12/2024 Phone Interview Toni ([REDACTED]): She explained that she no longer drives and De'Shawn Vaughn, her grandson uses the vehicle. She hasn't seen him or the vehicle in several months. From Toni's statement De'Shawn is the only user of the vehicle.

I called [REDACTED] to explain his vehicle is able to be released, got no response, so I left a voice message.

Euclid Report [REDACTED] De'Shawn fatally shot a Euclid PD officers at 335 E 211. Standoff occurred in Shaker Hts. De'Shawn was located in the barricaded apartment deceased.

05/13/2024 Euclid Detective Bureau: I conferred with Sgt. Maslik, and he is okay with us processing the Chrysler 200, and releasing it to Toni after we are done.

Vehicle Release [REDACTED] I conferred with [REDACTED] and explained that his vehicle was released.

05/14/2024 Prosecutor's Office: I conferred with APA Ferrari and a Motion to Withdraw a Warrant for De'Shawn was submitted to the Clerks and Warrant Unit for reason of abated by death.

Domestic Violence Threats / Aggravated Menacing

On May 6th, 2024 at 2055 hours, while assigned to 4B36 in company of P.O. Glick #331, we responded to [REDACTED] in c/w DVX.

Upon our arrival we were met by [REDACTED] (Victim #1), [REDACTED] (Victim #2) and [REDACTED] (Victim #3). Parties were uncooperative with providing details of the incident. [REDACTED] as well as her brother [REDACTED] continuously yelled at us and said her child's father Deshawn Vaughn (Suspect) just left in a Blue Chrysler with a silver passenger door. After asking [REDACTED] to explain what happened multiple times, she finally stated Vaughn pulled out a gun and threatened to shoot her, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]s younger brother [REDACTED] Victim#3). NARRATIVE

Title: Felonious Assault/Shooting/ Named Suspect

On Monday, May 6, 2024 while assigned to 5B33 in company with P.O. James #1208, we responded to 14106 Glenside Avenue at approximately 2241 hours in connection with multiple calls for a male shot. We were assisted on scene by 5S32 (Lt. Csoltko #8552), 5S33 (Sgt. Henderson #9293), and 5B32 (P.O. Murphy #1264 & P.O. White #1597).

Once on scene 5S32, Lt. Csoltko was rendering Aid to a male, later identified as [REDACTED] (victim), in the rear of a silver 2015 Ford Fusion (R845746). The victim had multiple apparent gunshot wounds to various parts of his body. We also observed multiple suspected bullet defects in the drivers side of the vehicle, two 9mm shell casings, and one bullet fragment on the ground near the victims vehicle. Med 30 arrived shortly after and transported the victim to UH main campus to be treated for his injuries.

While on scene, we spoke with [REDACTED] (interview). She stated that she is the sister of the victim. She stated that the person whom shot her brother was her child's father, DeShawn Vaughn (suspect). She stated that an incident occurred earlier in the day at her home (12802 Craven Avenue) in which she called her brother for assistance. The details of the incident are outlined in CAD # [REDACTED]. She stated that the suspect texted her phone and said "tell your brother that you love him." She stated that shortly after the text message was sent to her phone, she heard multiple gunshots outside and her brother was shot. She stated that the suspect drives a blue Chrysler 200 with a silver front passenger door. She stated that she did not witness the incident but she is confident that her child's father is the person whom shot her brother.

I spoke with Antonio Santiago on scene. He stated that he witnessed the shooting today. He stated that when he backed out of the driveway white 2016 Chrysler 200 (KGZ6741), he noticed a blue Chrysler 200 with the headlights off. He stated that the suspect vehicle was traveling east on Glenside avenue. He stated that he saw the suspect vehicle pull next to the victim's vehicle and someone from inside of the suspect's vehicle began shooting into the silver ford fusion. Mr. Santiago was accompanied in his vehicle by Aubriauna Landingham (witness) whom concurred with the story that Mr. Santiago told us on scene.

We were able to confer with [REDACTED] at UH hospital. The victim was in the ED inside of room #19. He stated that he went to his vehicle to get his I Pad. He stated that he sat in the driver's seat and noticed a blue Chrysler 200 with a silver door driving eastbound on Glenside Avenue. He stated that he knew that the vehicle belonged to the suspect. He stated that he thought that the suspect was approaching to talk about the incident that happened earlier in the day. He stated that the blue Chrysler 200 with a silver passanger door pull alongside of him and the one occupant inside of the vehicle began shooting. He stated that he felt a bullet hit him so he jumped into the backseat in which he was shot

multiple times again. The victim stated that he did not wish to complete a victim's rights packet at this time due to him being in extreme pain.

We spoke with Dr. Young, whom is treating the victim for his injuries at University Hospitals. He stated that the suspect was shot nine times and of the nine shots, a total of three bullets were retained in the victims body. He stated that two of the bullets were in soft tissue located in the victims back. He stated that the most concerning injury was the shot the the victim sustained in his pelvis. He stated that the victim will undergo surgery for his injuries and will be admitted into the hospital.

SIU was advised of a crime scene on Glenside Avenue but no one was able to respond at the time. We were advised by SIU and 5S33, Sgt. Henderson to Process tow the vehicle to lot 2 for processing. We were also advised to collect the shell casings and bullet fragment and MTE at D5. Multiple photos were taken via City Cell phone (216-327-7153) and uploaded to evidence.com via Axon Capture.

You have rights as a victim. Some rights you are automatically entitled to **and some rights you must request. You can use this form to choose to exercise all, some, or none of your rights.** You can change your selections at any time.

IMPORTANT

The below information can be **completed by the victim or the victim's representative** if one has been designated. Any acknowledgement, election of rights, or affirmative statement made by the victim's representative shall be treated as if the victim made the statement.

VICTIM STATUS

ELECTION OF YOUR VICTIM'S RIGHTS

As a victim, you are automatically entitled to:

- Be informed of your rights;
- Be treated with fairness and respect for your safety, dignity, and privacy;
- Reasonable protection from the accused or any person acting on behalf of the accused;
- Receive information about the status of the case;
- Refuse a defense interview, deposition, or other discovery request;
- Object to defense requests for access to your confidential information, including medical, counseling, school, or employment records, access to your personal devices, online accounts, or other personal information;



- Be present at all public proceedings;
- Have a support person with you during proceedings;
- Tell the court your opinion in public proceedings involving release, plea, sentencing, disposition, parole, and any other hearing that involves your rights;
- Object to unreasonable delays; and
- Full and timely restitution from the offender.

Below are rights that you must request in order to exercise. **You may choose some, none, or all of them.**

- Receive notice of the arrest, escape, or release of the offender;
