I went with multiple officers to clear the vehicle.

During the canvas, I knocked at 28 and 32 Wilbeth Rd. I had no answer at 32. There was an answer at 28 Wilbeth Rd. The resident stated that she did not see the incident. The resident had a camera on her garage but stated that it only captures her driveway and does not reach to the road. After the canvas, I was asked to make a list of officers that were involved or witnesses in order to help separate them. Massengill and I met back up and cleared from the call.

I arrived to the intersection of Wilbeth and Clairmont as shots began to start. I exited my cruiser and ran northbound into the parking lot. I positioned myself to the left of the Offices involved and asked them all if they were good. When they responded yes, I placed my gloves on my hands and we all moved in to place the suspect in handcuffs. I grabbed both of the suspects wrists and rolled him over onto his stomach. I continued to hold onto his left wrist then pulled his right wrist from under his body. I placed both wrists behind his back and another Officer placed handcuffs on the suspect. At this point other Officers arrived and immediately began to render aid. I held a flashlight for these Officers until AFD arrived.

I, Ofc. Bowers #1552, was working Car 12. We arrived at Wilbeth/Dallas providing backup to Car ■. Once on scene I and other officers began to move different cruisers to the side of the street on Wilbeth to make a pathway for EMS to get through. Once Med7 arrived on scene, Ofc. Hall #1530 and I guided EMS to the parking lot of Bridgestone where the incident occurred. As I approached the scene I witnessed multiple officers providing first aid to the suspect. Once Med 7 stopped I helped Ofc. White #1426 pull the gurney out of the ambulance and stage it near the suspect. I then stood by while Officers and paramedics continued to provide medical treatment. Myself and multiple other officers began to mark the ground where we found shell casings. I then went back to Wilbeth/Dallas and directed traffic away from the scene with Ofc. Luke #1497 until we were advised that we could clear from the scene.

I, Officer N Cockrell 1435, was working Car 3 with my partner, Ofc Reddish 1495. We tried to stay in the area of the chase to help block intersections. We were several streets south of the chase when the suspect bailed from the vehicle. We arrived at the scene shortly after the shots had been fired. I approached the suspect lying on the ground in the parking lot. He already had approximately eight officers around him, trying to treat his wounds. I assisted in opening medical gauze packages. Once AFD arrived on scene and determined the suspect had passed, I proceeded to help tape off the scene. Someone had reported there were some fireworks going off in the area at the time of the shooting so I checked houses in the area. I was unable to locate anyone that had been firing them off. I also got the names and ID numbers of the medical personnel/firefighters who were on scene. I handed that list over to Sgt Pasternak. From then on I just helped to secure the scene.

**NARRATIVE**

On Monday June 27th I was working uniformed patrol in district 7. Shortly after 0030hrs Car [REDACTED] called out with a vehicle pursuit. During the pursuit Car [REDACTED] stated (over the radio) that a shot had been fired from the suspects vehicle.

Minutes later, the suspect vehicle was traveling westbound on Wilbeth in my direction. I was assisting with blocking vehicle traffic at the intersection of Wilbeth/ South Main St. After observing the suspect vehicle drastically slowing down, I observed the suspect fleeing (on foot) northbound into a nearby parking lot. I approached the parking lot and exited my cruiser.

As I opened my cruiser door, shots were actively being fired. I went behind my cruiser (to a place of cover) and approached the parking lot from a safer vantage point. As I approached on foot, I observed several officers in a staggered line. I immediately began to shout "cross fire, crossfire" in an attempt to improve officer safety.

When I observed the suspect, he was lying on his back. The suspects right arm was in a 90 degree angle with his forearm/hand extended outward (common shooting stance). I began to shout "watch his hands". The suspects right arm was moving. His bent right arm was moving from his right side, upwards towards his face. I faintly heard one officer say "gun" at which time I asked "Where's the weapon at?". "An unknown officer stated we don't know?"

Seconds later an officer (located closer to the suspect and a better vantage point) gave the command to move in and handcuff/ provide medical aid to the suspect. Officers moved in and immediately began to provide medical aid to the suspect.

I remained on scene to assist in scene security.

On 06/27/2022 Officer (Ofc.) R. Hall #1530 and I (Ofc. D. Fields #1506) were assigned to work uniformed patrol in district 8. At approximately 0030hrs AKA7 was dispatched to a welfare check (2022-078917) for a male that wasn't supposed to be at this address in the area of 5th Ave, which I advised dispatch that we'd assist with.

At approximately 0036 I heard [REDACTED] attempt a traffic stop on the listed suspect's vehicle. We continued to search for the unknown male to AKA7's welfare check. While in the area of 4th St SW/ Maryland Ave, I heard [REDACTED] announce Sig21, the suspect vehicle just fired a round out of his vehicle. I headed to the area of E Wilbeth Rd/ Mission Dr where I assisted with blocking intersections for the vehicle pursuit. As the pursuit passed us going West on E Wilbeth Ave, I began driving West on Wilbeth in an attempt to continue blocking intersections.

While in the process of making a northbound turn onto Evergreen Ave to assist with blocking intersection if the pursuit went North, the officers calling out the pursuit stated the suspect vehicle was starting to slow down near E Wilbeth Rd/Clairmont Ave. I continued to drive West on E Wilbeth Rd to catch up to the other units believing the armed suspect was in the process of bailing out of the vehicle.

As we approached the intersection of Dallas Ave/E Wilbeth Rd the suspect fled from the vehicle on foot running North bound toward a large brick building. I grabbed my patrol rifle and began running NorthWest in an attempt to catch the suspect. As I approached the parking lot, the Officer involved shooting occurred. I advised all units to get onto line and held lethal coverage on the suspect until he was taken into custody.

I advised dispatch and all units enroute that we needed a Medical bag for the suspect, to get AFD medics enroute, and to have them approach from the east. I then ran back toward our cruiser, securing other cruisers on the way. I moved several cruisers on E Wilbeth Ave, East of Clairmont Ave to make an entrance point for AFD medics. I waited near the intersection of Dallas Ave/ E Wilbeth Ave to ensure the cruiser that was blocking the intersection could be moved when needed for officers and medics.

Eventually I was advised to take our cruiser to the intersection of Clairmont Ave/Palmetto Ave to block traffic. While blocking traffic I assisted with placing crime scene tape around the southside of the scene. I remained on the southside of the scene at our cruiser until we were eventually relieved by dayshift.

We cleared assist and left the scene.

Then I observed the suspect on the ground. I got online with the other officers and maintained coverage of the suspect as he was handcuffed. An officer requested gloves so that they could render medical aide. I then pulled out the trauma kit that I carry on my duty belt. I then ran back to the cruiser I came in and returned my patrol rifle to it. Then, as EMS approached, I assisted in guiding them to the lot where the suspect was. I then found my partner. My body camera was collected. We were instructed to hold and secure an intersection, Clairemont Ave and Palmetto Ave. I placed crime scene tape around the church parking lot. We then ensured no civilians entered the scene for several hours. I was then instructed by Lt. Marks to do a tow inventory of the suspect vehicle. I completed the tow report and gave it to the CSU detective following the vehicle from the scene. I then returned to the intersection to maintain security of the scene. Shortly after, we were relieved by a day shift officer. We cleared the scene.

Car [REDACTED] was behind us following us from S. Main St. I thought the suspect vehicle would continue going south on 77S. We arrived on scene with the other officers at 0038 hours and 22 seconds. At that time the suspect was laying on he ground and officers began to approach him with guns drawn. I approached as well with my firearm drawn. Multiple other officers immediately began to provide medical treatment to the suspect.

I then started asking officers were the suspect vehicle was and if anyone else was in the vehicle. One of the officers said the vehicle was over there, meaning across the street. I started running across the street with other officers to clear the vehicle of potential other suspects. Once I got to the vehicle, I identified myself as Akron police and if anyone else was in the vehicle to have their hands up. Myself, Officer Hensley 1509, and other officers cleared the vehicle. There was no one else in the vehicle.

I then went back to Wilbeth Road and started to move cruisers to the side of the road and securing ones that were left unlocked. I then went on the perimeter on Wilbeth Road on the east side of the scene. I was there to prevent unauthorized people or vehicles from entering the area. I was eventually cleared to leave the scene by Sgt. Sinsley 1247. I then met up with my partner Officer Parker and we went back into service.

While in route car ■ radioed that shots were fired from within the suspect vehicle. We went to S. Main Street and then got onto 76E to 77S. As we got onto 77S, car ■ radioed that the vehicle would be coming up to our side and to be careful. Our vehicle at this time was in the lead. Car ■ was behind us following us from S. Main St. I thought the suspect vehicle would continue going south on 77S. We were almost passed the exit to Archwood Ave. and the vehicle then got off. We were not able to get off of the exit without slamming on the breaks slightly to the left of the exit. At that time we waited for all the cruisers that were following the suspect vehicle to pass us before we got off the exit.

We then parallel the chase going west on Firestone Blvd. to S. Main Street. We then went south on S. Main Street and east on Wilbeth Road. We arrived on scene with the other officers at 0038 hours and 22 seconds. At that time the suspect was laying on he ground and officers began to approach him with guns drawn. I approached as well with my firearm drawn. Multiple other officers immediately began to provide medical treatment to the suspect.

Seeing that there was plenty of officers on scene with the suspect, I looked around for the suspects vehicle. I spotted it a moment later, crashed into the north wall of the church on the south side of the street. I saw a couple officers starting to approach the vehicle to clear it. Seeing that the vehicle was being taken care of, I started to search the area between the suspect and he vehicle was for any type of evidence the suspect might have dropped. Nothing was found.

I then started to help expand the perimeter of the crime scene south on Clairmont Ave. After I finished putting crime scene tape up I relieved Officer Marcum from guarding the suspect vehicle. Sgt. Orande arrived on scene and myself and officer Marcum shut the car off. Shortly after that myself and Officer Luke were told to go into service.

As the chase proceeded, I heard car [REDACTED] announce over the radio that a shot was fired from the suspect vehicle and that the officers were not struck. I was in the station at the time but got in my cruiser and drove to the area of the chase. The suspect vehicle was travelling west on Wilbeth Rd approaching S Main St. Several other cruisers and I stopped oncoming traffic at the intersection of S Main St and Wilbeth Rd so that the chase could proceed safely.

While still at the intersection, I heard an officer call out that the suspect vehicle was slowing down. Shortly after, I saw a gold firework erupt over the treeline to the east of my location. I then heard a large amount of pops that sounded like gunfire right after I saw the firework. Due to the close proximity of seeing the firework and hearing the pops, I could not distinguish which pops were from the fireworks and which pops were gunfire. I didn't immediately hear anything over the radio so I went east on Wilbeth Rd towards the sounds. As I was approaching, I heard an officer announce over the radio that shots were fired and a med unit was requested. When I arrived on scene, I saw a lot of officers near the suspect who was laying on the ground in the parking lot of the Firestone building.

Sgt. Tersigni was with the officers near the suspect. Sgt. Tersigni directed the officers that fired their weapons towards me while the other officers on scene rendered medical aid. I sequestered Officers Trawick, Filimon, Galz, Ritzinger, Carmany and Bishop in separate cruisers. I also collected their Body Worn Cameras. Sgt. Sinsley provided me with Body Worn Cameras from Officers Siegfert, Sweeney who were involved in the incident and four officers who witnessed the incident. I transferred custody of the Body Worn Cameras to Det. S. Flail from the CSU unit. I assisted with scene security until I was no longer needed. I then cleared the call and resumed patrol.

**NARRATIVE**

I was working car AKE14 in the area of the Triplett pumps when I heard car [REDACTED] call out that they had a traffic stop that was turning into a chase and headed down Rt 8 South. I decided to head in the direction of where I believed that the car could flee to. Car [REDACTED] gave information over the radio that there was a gun shot from inside the vehicle. They stated that the vehicle had gone onto I 77S from Rt 8 and had gotten off at the Archwood exit. I tried to stay in the area as the vehicle continued to flee, but made sure i was never in the chase. I was on E Wilbeth Rd and Brown St when I saw the suspect vehicle make a westbound turn onto E Wilbeth Rd followed by the pursuing officers. I believed that there was a chance that the suspect would try and circle the area or double back. I headed to N. Firestone Blvd and headed westbound towards Main St. I had just gotten to Firestone Blvd and Main St when I heard that the suspect was fleeing on foot. I quickly made my way down Main St to the last known location on Wilbeth.

As I arrived on scene I got out of my cruiser to find a line of officers approaching the suspect on the ground. They placed him in handcuffs. I saw that the suspect had been shot multiple times across his body. I put on gloves and began to render aid. I applied a tourniquet to the suspect's right leg and a chest seal to his chest. The suspect had agonal breathing and a weak pulse. I helped apply pressure to the additional wounds that had no bandages. EMS approached and found no pulse. I started CPR until I was relieved by AFD. Shortly after they checked his vitals and found him to be deceased.

I remained on scene to help outline the scene as to where shell casings were found. Having worked years prior at the location where the suspect was shot at, I made contact with the Securitas Officer in Charge. I asked what full time Bridgestone security staff would be in charge. He gave me the name of Mike Desanis, who I knew from working there. I got a contact number for Mike and advised the Securitas officer to contact Mike and let him know that there was an incident and that Detectives would likely be contacting him shortly. I gave the contact information to Det. Aber on scene.

I remained on scene guarding the inner crime scene. While there I located an additional taser barb that was outside of the crime scene tape. I notified both BCI and Detectives on scene to make sure the Evidence wouldn't be missed. I remained on scene until BCI and Lieutenant Marks dismissed me.
