RE: Bonds of the City of Akron, Summit County, Ohio,

I have examined the transcript of proceedings relative to the above bonds purchased by you. These bonds comprise part of an issue of sewer bonds in the aggregate amount of \$500,000, dated April 1, 1920, and bearing interest at the rate of 5½% per annum.
