CONSENT ENTRY

The motion for a preliminary injunction having been filed in the above-referenced action on January 30, 1986, and Plaintiff State of Ohio and Defendant Buffalo Oilfield Services, Inc. ("Buffalo") having consented to the entry of this decree without Buffalo's admission or denial of fact or law arising from the complaint, it is ORDERED AND DECREED as follows:

A. Buffalo, its agents and employees, are preliminarily enjoined to refrain from injecting brine into the Gates No. 1, Michaleski No. 1, Johnson No. 1, Solera No. 1, Hill No. 1, Oros No. 1, and Gingerich-Szabo No. 1 wells at surface pressures greater than that approved under their respective Permits.

B. Buffalo, its agents and employees, are preliminarily enjoined from allowing brine to escape from the diked areas either through leaching or directly through openings in the side of the dikes at the tank batteries of the Gates No. 1, Michaleski No. 1, Johnson No. 1, Solera No. 1, and Oros No. 1 wells.

C. Buffalo, its agents and employees, are preliminarily enjoined from failing to keep the area inside the dikes at the Gates No. 1, Michaleski No. 1, Hill No. 1, Solera No. 1 and Oros No. 1 tank batteries reasonably free of brine and other waste substances.
