CONSENT ORDER FOR TERMINATION OF STIPULATED PENALTIES

WHEREAS, Plaintiff, the State of Ohio, by its Attorney General (hereinafter "Plaintiff"), and Defendant, the City of Lancaster, Ohio (hereinafter "Lancaster") entered into a Consent Decree filed by the Court in this matter on July 20, 1990 ("Consent Decree");


WHEREAS, Paragraph 19 of the Consent Decree provides that the provisions of Consent Decree set forth in Paragraphs 13-17 of the Consent Decree relating to stipulated penalties shall terminate if Lancaster has achieved and maintained compliance with the effluent limitations contained in its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit for a period of one (1) year and has paid all penalties required pursuant to the Consent Decree;

NOW, THEREFORE, Plaintiff, the State of Ohio, and Defendant, the City of Lancaster hereby stipulate as follows:

1. Lancaster has achieved and maintained compliance with the effluent limitations contained in its NPDES permit for a period of one (1) year and has paid all penalties required pursuant to the Consent Decree.

2. The provisions of the Consent Decree set forth in Section IX, Paragraphs 13-17 relating to stipulated penalties shall terminate upon entry of this Consent Order.
