


Plaintiff State of Ohio having moved from a preliminary injunction, and the Court having concluded that motion has merit, it is


ORDERED, that Defendant is preliminarily enjoined from placing additional saltwater on Township Road 155 in Clay Township, Knox County in a manner not approved by the Chief of the Division of Oil and Gas pursuant to Section 1509.22 of the Ohio Revised Code and from disposing of saltwater in such a manner on other lands and waters of this State pending a hearing on Plaintiff's Complaint.

Acceptable methods of disposal of brine at this time include, but are not limited to, the spreading of brine on county and township roads for dust and ice control where such spreading is approved by the appropriate local authorities, in writing, and the chief of the division of oil and gas so long as such methods of disposal do not result in the contamination or pollution of the groundwaters or surface waters of this state.
