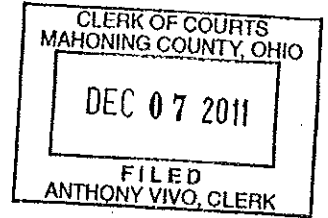

JUDGMENT ENTRY

This is an administrative appeal brought pursuant to R.C. 4141.282 from a Decision of the State of Ohio Unemployment Compensation Review Commission denying the application of Appellant, Jeffery L. Proch ("Appellant") for training under the Trade Adjustment Assistance program. The Court has considered the briefs of the parties and the entire Record on Appeal.

Appellant has been accepted into the Executive MBA program at the University of Pittsburgh Katz School of Business for which he seeks financial assistance. The sole basis that the Review Commission denied the Appellant's request was that the cost was not reasonable and required by 20 C.F.R. 617(a)(6) since "at least four programs were available in his commuting area at a lower costs [sic]." However, the Commission ignored the only evidence in the record that the Katz program was the only one which had a specific international business program, uniquely suited for Appellant's needs.

Therefore, the Court finds that the Decision of the Unemployment Review Commission is unlawful, unreasonable and against the manifest weight of the evidence and is reversed.
