
ENTRY OF REMAND

This cause came on to be heard upon an appeal from the final decision of the Ohio Unemployment Compensation Review Commission. Despite due diligence by the Review Commission, the certified transcript is incomplete as the audio recording of the evidentiary hearing before the Review Commission could not be transcribed due to equipment malfunction. Thus, there is no record upon which the Court can base its decision as required by R.C. 4141.282(H).

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this matter is remanded to the Review Commission in order to conduct a *de novo* hearing concerning the merits of the unemployment compensation claim of Appellee Jesse Estep.

Costs of this matter shall be charged to the Appellee, Director, Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.
