This matter is before the Court upon the Certified Record filed September 24, 2014, the Brief of Appellant filed January 12, 2015, the Brief of Appellee Ohio Department of Job and Family Services filed January 27, 2015, exhibits, and other supporting documents herein.

The standard of review in this case requires the Court to affirm the decision of the unemployment compensation review commission unless the decision was unlawful, unreasonable, or against the manifest weight of the evidence. In other words, the reviewing Court cannot rewrite the commission's decision based upon the fact that the Court would interpret the evidence differently. Finally, the reviewing Court must affirm the commission's decision as long as some credible evidence supports that decision.


In reviewing the record, there is no question that this Court may very well have interpreted the evidence differently than the hearing officer who heard this case. It is also clear that reasonable minds can certainly differ in determining the appropriate resolution of this matter. However, the Court cannot overturn the commission's decision based upon that analysis.

This Court is required to determine if there was some credible evidence that supported the commission's decision. In reviewing the record, the Court does find that such credible

evidence does exist. Therefore, it is ORDERED that the July 30, 2014 decision of the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission shall be and is hereby affirmed.
