This matter came for review on Respondent's Motion to Dismiss, Petitioner's Motion to Permit Reinstatement, and the parties' Briefs. Oral argument was held October 1, 2015.

Upon review of the motions and arguments, it is ORDERED that Petitioner's case is dismissed because this Court lacks subject matter jurisdiction. This Court finds that Petitioner did not file its notice of appeal with the Bureau of Motor Vehicles within fifteen days of the mailing of the notice of the Bureau of Motor Vehicle's Order, as required by R.C. 119.12.

This Court also finds that even if the Court had subject matter jurisdiction to hear the appeal, Petitioner failed to exhaust administrative remedies and therefore forfeited his opportunity to raise arguments on the merits to this Court.


