These bonds are undoubtedly authorized by the following provision of section 6290-1, General Code, which states:

“\* \* \* When in the opinion of the director of highways, it is deemed advisable, any deputy or other employee may be required to give bond in such amount and with such security as he may approve.  
\* \* \* ”

Upon examination of the foregoing bonds, I find same to be in proper legal form in accordance with applicable statutory provisions, and therefore same are hereby approved as to legal form and returned herewith.
