LEASE—CANAL LAND, STATE WITH THE PICKAWAY
GRAIN COMPANY, DESIGNATED PORTION, OHIO CANAL,
CIRCLEVILLE, PICKAWAY COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a canal land lease in triplicate executed by you as Superintendent of Public Works and as Director of such department, to The Pickaway Grain Company of Circleville, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$12.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for storage purposes that portion of the abandoned Ohio Canal, including the full width of the bed and banks thereof, located in the city of Circleville, Pickaway County, Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:
