APPROVAL—CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RICHLAND COUNTY AND
THE STATE OF OHIO FOR CLEARFORK CREEK BRIDGE
IMPROVEMENT.

HON. JOHN JASTER, JR., *Director of Highways, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my consideration and approval, as to form and legality, a contract between the Board of County Commissioners of Richland County, Ohio, and the Director of Highways, covering the proposed improvement described as, Bridge No. RI-13-53 (Kocheiser Bridge) over Clearfork Creek, and approaches thereto, located on the Mt. Vernon-Mansfield Road, State Highway No. 338, in the Village of Bellville, Ohio.

Attached thereto is a certificate of the County Auditor of Richland County, certifying that the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars, being the portion of the cost of said improvement assumed by Richland County, is in the treasury of said county to the credit of the State and County Road Improvement Fund and not appropriated for any other purpose.

Also there is attached a certificate of the Director of Finance certifying that there are sufficient funds in the appropriation to the Department of Highways, not otherwise obligated, and thereby set aside as the State's share of the cost of the proposed improvement.

After examination, I find the said contract in proper legal form, and have accordingly endorsed my approval thereon and am returning the same herewith.
