

3. Where the bank holds title to such fund which is administered by one of its departments, it is prohibited by Section 710-114, General Code, from investing any part of the fund in the bank's own stock.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain findings made by your immediate predecessor in office, Hon. T. S. Brindle, with respect to certain adjustments of current and delinquent rentals upon applications therefor filed respectively by certain lessees of abandoned Miami and Erie Canal lands, under the authority of House Bill No. 467, 115 O.
