GENTLEMEN:—The transcript submitted in connection with the above bond issue
discloses that said bonds are issued under authority of House Bill No. 254.

It is the opinion of this department that the provisions of House Bill No. 254
were repealed by the Griswold Act which went into effect January 1, 1922, and
that the boards of education are without authority since that date to issue defi-
ciency bonds thereunder.

I am therefore of the opinion that said bonds of Defiance township rural
school district, Defiance county, are not valid and binding obligations of the school
district, and advise you to decline to purchase the same.
