APPROVAL, BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF HIS
DUTIES AS TREASURER OF KENT STATE COLLEGE.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, July 19, 1933.

Board of Trustees, Kent State College, Kent, Ohio.

GENTLEMEN:—There has been submitted a bond for the sum of \$30,000.00 upon which Edward Leslie Bowsher appears as principal and The Glen Falls Indemnity Company of Glen Falls, New York, as surety, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of said principal as Treasurer of Kent State College.

Such bond is undoubtedly executed pursuant to the provisions of Section 4 of House Bill 44 as enacted by the 78th General Assembly (101 O. L. 320). Said section requires such treasurer to give a bond in a sum to be determined by the trustees, which shall not be for a less sum than the estimated amount which may come into such treasurer's control at any one time. The section further requires the bond to be approved by the Attorney General.

There has further been submitted a certified copy of the resolution of the Board of Trustees adopted July 11, 1933, which fixes the treasurer's bond at the sum of \$30,000.00.

After examination of the bond, I find same to be in proper form, executed in pursuance of law, with the exception that in the tenth and thirteenth lines of the bond and in the third line of the oath the word "Normal" should be omitted from the words "Kent State Normal College." In section 1 of Amended Substitute Senate Bill No. 70, passed by the 88th General Assembly on March 20, 1929 (113 O. L. 34), the name of the Kent State Normal School, established pursuant to House Bill 44 of the 78th General Assembly (101 O. L. 320), heretofore mentioned, was changed to "Kent State College."

Subject to this correction, I am approving said bond. I have endorsed my approval on the bond and am returning same, together with all other data submitted therewith.
