BOARD OF EDUCATION—MAY APPOINT ONE PERSON TO TWO POSITIONS OF ASSISTANT COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND COUNTY ATTENDANCE OFFICER WHEN—(O. A. G. 1921 P. 793; 1928, P. 956 MODIFIED).

*SYLLABUS:*

*A county board of education may in its discretion appoint an assistant county superintendent of schools or a county attendance officer for part time service, and may under such circumstances, lawfully appoint one person to the two positions.
