GALLIPOLIS LOCKS AND DAM—GALLIA COUNTY—APPROVAL—PROPOSAL OR CONVEYANCE, EIGHT TRACTS OF LAND, FLOWAGE RIGHTS, CLAY, GALLIPOLIS AND ADDISON TOWNSHIPS.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, February 21, 1939.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval a proposal wherein under the provisions of Section 1178-4 of the General Code, you offer to convey the flowage rights upon eight tracts of land described therein and designated as:

Said lands form a part of the State Highway system in Gallia County, Ohio and the necessity for such proposal or conveyance grows out of the construction of the Gallipolis locks and dam. Under the terms of said proposal, in the event that it is accepted by the War Department, the State will receive the sum of \$129,079.00, plus interest of six per cent from the date of acceptance of said offer.

After an examination, it is my opinion that said proposal is in proper legal form and accordingly I have endorsed my approval thereon as to form.
