AGREEMENT—STATE WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY, ELIMINATION GRADE CROSSING OVER TRACKS OF THE COMPANY, SH 370, STATION 15, HARRISON COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted a proposed agreement between yourself as Director of Highways of the State of Ohio, and The Pennsylvania Railroad Company covering the matter of the elimination of the grade crossing over the tracks of The Pennsylvania Railroad Company on State Highway No. 370, located at a point in Harrison County, Ohio known as Station 15.
