Gentlemen:—

Transcript furnished this department in connection with the foregoing bond issue contains only an "ordinance to issue bonds in the sum of \$1,200.00 to pay the village's portion of the cost and expense of paving sidewalks."

The transcript contains no legislation whatever showing authority for an issue for this purpose, and as the ordinance contains no provision for a levy to meet the maturing bonds and interest, I am of the opinion that the bonds sought to be issued are not valid and legal obligations to the village, and you are therefore advised not to purchase the same.
