BOND ISSUE—UNAUTHORIZED BY COUNTY FOR PURPOSE OF
ERECTING COURTHOUSE OR OTHER COUNTY BUILDING, COST-
ING MORE THAN \$25,000, WITHOUT CONSENT OF ELECTORS.

SYLLABUS:

Bonds may not be issued by a county for the purpose of erecting a courthouse or other county building, which is to cost more than twenty-five thousand dollars,
