APPROVAL, LEASE FOR RIGHT TO USE AND OCCUPY FOR COTTAGE SITE, BOATHOUSE AND DOCKLANDING PURPOSES, LAND AT BUCKEYE LAKE—JOHN F. SMETZ.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication, over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes & Parks in the Conservation Division of your Department, submitting for my examination and approval a certain lease executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one John F. Smetz of Columbus, Ohio.

By the lease here in question, there is leased and demised to said John F. Smetz for a stated term of fifteen years, and at an annual rental of \$18.00, the right to use and occupy for cottage site, boathouse and docklanding purposes that portion of the inner slope and water front and outer slope and borrow pit adjacent thereto, that is included in the north half of Embankment Lot No. 41, south of Lakeside, as laid out on the west embankment of Buckeye Lake by the Ohio Canal Commission. Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by the lessee above named.

I likewise find, upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with the provisions of section 471, General Code, and with all other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith enclosed.
