Narrative:

On Tuesday, November 22, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Matt Collins (SA Collins) received requested records and recordings from Ross County Sheriff's Office (RCSO) Sgt. Jason Gannon. SA Collins had previously requested all dispatch records, audio recordings (radio, 911, and phone), mobile data terminal (MDT) communications, and any other dispatch/communications-related to the incident. As a result of that request, the following items were received and reviewed:

Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) Records:

There are two files which contain dispatch records. The first file was titled, "Radio Log." The records indicated the shooting incident was reported or otherwise made aware to RCSO dispatch on November 17, 2022, at 17:30:20 hours. The second file was titled, "CPD report." There dispatch records show the call was initiated at **17:19:49**.

Radio Traffic Recordings:

The recordings consist of sixteen audio files, titled with their respective date and time (i.e. "RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_19_06"):

- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_19_06*- Unit 586 advised he was in route.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_23_24*- Unit 574 advised he was responding.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_28_43*- Unit 574 advised he was going to be riding with the squad to Adena.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_29_36*- An unknown unit asked if anyone was following the squad "with our guy in it?" Unit 574 responded, stating he was. As, well as Unit 586.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_48_09*- Unit 782 advised he was "3-7" at Adena.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_49_48*- Dispatch advised Unit 360, BCI was on "19." Unit 360 advised they were walking around the building.



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- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_17_56_44*- Unit 54 advised they were in route to "A-R-M-C."
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_18_06_21*- Unit 54 advised he was "87" at "A-R-M-C." Unit; an Unknown unit advised they were "5-8 still."
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_18_11_14*- Unit 54 advised he was "clear of A-R-M-C and in route to 2-5"
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_19_09_58*- Unit 433 advised he was out at the V-A police department.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_19_22_10*- Several units spoke back and forth reference ensuring the scene was secure and what units could be relieved.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_19_24_18*- Unit 360 and Unit 433 coordinated where other units were needed to be.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_19_26_07*- Unit 501 was directed by Unit 360, to go to one of the interview rooms.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_21_40_55*- Unit 54 advised Unit 368 "they" wanted whoever was going to go to Bowdle Rd, to come to Unit 54's location first, the Family Dollar by McDonalds.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_21_41_53*- An unknown unit advised unit 368 "they" wanted him to meet with their group before going.
- *RSCO_Main_Marcs_2022_11_17_22_13_55*- Unit 368 advised he had a "signal 7"; "John William, Union 24, 17" (JWU2417).

There was no other Radio Traffic. SA Collins inquired with Sgt. Gannon of any additional radio traffic prior to those listed above, whereas there was communication dictating the responses. On January 19, 2023, SA Collins received an email from Sgt. Gannon. The email contained seventeen (17) audio files. The files were individually titled with the date and time included in the title (i.e. "*CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_17_00*").

- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_17_00*- A female (Dispatcher) voice is heard saying, "All Units start to two-five, all units start to two-five. Deputy shot, deputy shot. Units in route--"
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_17_23*- Dispatch says, "All units two-five, two-five, rear of two-five, suspect is still in the area with a code forty." Unit #119 advised they were clearing a crash and en route. Another unit advised they were in the area and requested a description.



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- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_18_04*- Dispatch stated, "County's advising, they believe he's code sixteen outside."
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_19_15*- A male voice stated, "Headquarters have EMS start in, we've got him secured in the back."
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_20_33*- Dispatch advised the squad was going to stage. A male voice told them the scene was secure and for them to come in.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_21_12*- A male requested there be two medics due to the subject being shot as well. Dispatch acknowledged, stating they already had another one in route.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_23_37*- A male requested an "engine" and dispatch confirmed they were in route as well.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_26_33*- Unit #4 advised he was going to call Unit #1 and he requested dispatch to call an on-call detective in.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_28_25*- Unit #119 advised they were en route to ARMC.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_36_05*- An unknown unit asked, "where's everybody at?"
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_37_42*- An unknown unit advised Unit #28 to leave their truck first.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_41_10*- Unit #8 advised he was arriving at two-five.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_42_15*- an unknown unit asked if Unit #8 was on second street and Unit #8 answered in the affirm.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_51_24*- Unit #28 advised they had a signal seven.
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_51_41*- Unit #28 advised, "Paul, seven, seven, eight, seven, eight, three." Plate #P778783
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_54_00*- Dispatch advised there were off-duty units requesting to come in. An Unknown unit advised they believed they "got it sufficient at this time."
- *CPD_Main_Radio_2022_11_17_17_54_29*- Multiple units coordinated additional responses and where to meet.

911 Calls:

There were no 911 Calls made. The incident occurred at the sheriff's office.



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Other Phone Calls (other than 911):

There were no calls made to report the incident. The call was initiated by radio traffic.

Initial Narrative By Tony Wheaton, 11/18/22 08:24

On 11-17-22 I was contacted by Capt. Addy, where I instructed to respond to the Ross County Sheriff's Office in reference to a shooting that involved an Officer with the Ross County Sheriff's Office.

Investigative Notes Narrative By Max Adair, 11/18/22 07:32

On November 17, 2022, I was walking northbound on N. Paint St., Chillicothe, near the area of the Ross County Common Pleas Courthouse and the Law Enforcement Complex (LEC) when I observed two Chillicothe Police cruisers with lights and sirens activated pull onto N. Paint St and turn down the alley between the two buildings. I proceeded around the corner of the LEC onto W. 2nd St. and began walking to the back parking lot of the LEC. Upon reaching the fence by the employee break area I received a phone call from Sgt. McGoye who stated Sgt. Kocheran had been shot. I informed Sgt. McGoye that I was on scene and ended the call. I continued around the corner of the building and observed Chillicothe Police Officers and RCSO Sgt. Gallagher near an unknown male subject who was lying on the

ground outside the building. There was blood around the unknown male. I also observed RSCO Corrections Deputies and a Chillicothe Police Dispatcher tending to Sgt. Kocheran, who was lying on the floor inside the rear door of the LEC. I began making phone calls to get additional personnel to the scene while awaiting EMS.

I was later interviewed by Ohio BCI about this incident.

Investigative Notes Narrative By Tony Wheaton, 11/18/22 08:31

On 11-17-22 I received information from Capt. Addy that an officer with the Ross County Sheriff's Office had been involved in a shooting while on the property of the Ross County Sheriff's Office. Upon arrival at the Ross County Sheriff's Office I found that the rear parking lot had been cordoned off. With officers from the Ross County Sheriff's Office and Chillicothe Police Department maintaining security.

I was informed that Sgt. Eric Kocheran had been shot by an unknown male at the rear door of the Ross County Law Enforcement Complex. Sgt. Kocheran was able to return fire and did strike this person. I was additionally informed that both had been transported to Adena Regional Hospital for treatment.

I confirmed that BCI&I had been contacted and that due to an officer involved shooting this investigation would be conducted by BCI&I. Security of the scene was maintained and turned over to BCI&I upon their arrival.

Investigative Notes Narrative By Thomas Hamman, 11/18/22 09:54

Follow-up

On the evening of 11/17/2022, I returned from a follow-up on a previous call. Upon arrival, I learned of the shooting of Sgt E KOCHERAN. SGT KOCHERAN was being transported to ARMC as I arrived and the other male suspect was being loaded for transport. I observed a serious wound to the head and excessive bleeding from the nose. From previous experience in investigations, I felt that the injury was possibly fatal. It was determined that the identity of the person was unknown. At this time, I went to ARMC and met with Sgt Z MCGOYE at the trauma bay holding the unidentified male. Sgt E KOCHERAN was being treated in the neighboring trauma bay.

When the medical staff call a time of death of the unidentified male, Sgt MCGOYE and I entered the bay and stood by for the Coroner's investigators. Coroner Inv MARK GRAY was present. Inv SCOTT LAGARD was enroute. I asked to be able to take photographs of the suspect's highly visible tattoos on his arms and the identifiable birthmark on his abdomen, for purposes of identifying the unknown suspect. These pictures were transmitted to Capt J ADDY, Capt M ADAIR, CPD Capt Tim GAY and Sgt J GALLAGHER, at the jail, in an effort to identify the subject, since no identification papers were present, with the body. BCI personnel arrived to process the body and collect evidence.

Inv MARK GRAY and myself presented the photos to ER admission staff, the 1-A ward staff and the mental health staff at the ER in an effort to determine an identification. All results were negative.

When I returned to the trauma bay, the SO personnel had left and the Coroner's Office personnel were awaiting transport to Montgomery County Coroner's Office for autopsy. It was determined that OSHP Sgt BROWN would provide escort to Dayton.

I returned to RSCO LEC, met with Capt ADDY and Sgt PIERCE and upon notification that there was an identification of the body, I went off duty.

Investigative Notes Narrative By Kevin Pierce, 11/18/22 10:03

Case follow up

Capt Addy advised me to respond to the Adena Hospital ER in reference to a shooting. I arrived and made contact with Capt Addy, and were advised that BCI was taking over the investigation of the shooting. We did stay at the ER until BCI agents arrived and turned everything over to them.

Investigative Notes Narrative By Jason Gannon, 11/18/22 12:31

On November 17th 2022 I responded to Adena Medical Center to assist with an officer involved shooting. I then contacted Captain Stanley "Joe" Addy and assisted in attempting to identify the unidentified male decedent. I later assisted in looking for the unidentified male decedents vehicle. After the vehicle was located I was asked to have the vehicle towed and secured in the evidence building at SIU. I contacted Gary Hall and requested he tow the vehicle to SIU. I stood by with the vehicle at the Family Dollar at North Bridge and East Second St in Chillicothe, OH until Gary Hall arrived with a tow truck. After the vehicle was loaded I followed the vehicle and I secured it in the evidence building at SIU. The building the vehicle was secured in has limited access and I also left a note of the vehicle that it

was evidence. I then placed crime scene tape at the entrance to the door and locked both the vehicle and the building. I secured the keys in my office at SIU pending a search to be conducted later by the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation's, Crime Scene Unit.

I have nothing further at this time. I was not interviewed by the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation's, Investigators.

Investigative Notes Narrative By Stanley Addy, 11/21/22 08:31

On 11/17/2022 I was requested to Adena Hospital on an officer involved shooting, while en-rout contact was made with Detective Wheaton and Detective Crosier whom responded to the Ross Count Law Complex to hold the scene for bureau of criminal Investigations. Contact was made with Detective Pierce who responded with myself to Adena Regional and the scene was secured until the Bureau of criminal investigations Agents arrived at the hospital. The investigation was turned over to their Agency at my request.

Initial Narrative By Shane Daubenmire, 11/17/22 21:50

Officers were dispatched to 28 N PAINT ST, CHILLICOTHE on a shooting, investigation continues.

Supplement Narrative By Matthew Richardson, 11/17/22 20:20

While on patrol, dispatch advised all officers to respond to the law complex and that a deputy had been shot at the rear of the building.

Upon arrival, I met with Ofc. Daubenmire who was holding a male at gun point and RCSO Sgt. Gallagher was handcuffing the male who was laying in a pool of blood. I put on gloves and conducted a frisk of the male for any weapons and none were located. I rolled the male into the recovery position and located a gun shot wound to the left side of his head. I rendered aid by applying pressure to the wound until medics from Chillicothe Fire Department arrived on scene to take over in administering aid. During this time, I noted the male was taking slow gasping breaths. I then stood by as scene security until told to clear by command staff.

I have no further involvement.

Supplement Narrative By Shane Daubenmire, 11/17/22 21:51

I responded to the law complex after radio traffic from dispatch advising a Deputy had been shot. I arrived in the area and dispatch updated that the suspect was in the rear of the building. I responded to the rear employee door of the law complex. I noted an unidentified male suspect laying on his back and a puddle of blood in the area of his head. I noted that Sgt. Gallagher from the RCSO was in the back doorway holding the suspect at gunpoint. I noted that Deputy Kocheran was laying a short distance inside the doorway on his back and an unknown female employee was assisting him. I provided Sgt. Gallagher with my handcuffs and I held lethal cover on the suspect. Officers approached the suspect and I held lethal cover while Sgt. Gallagher applied handcuffs to the suspect. I noted a semi-auto handgun on the ground behind the suspect in the puddle of blood. Ofc. Richardson had arrived and assisted with a pat down of the suspect. By this time other Officers had arrived and were assisting Deputy Kocheran. I noted the suspect had what appeared to be a gunshot wound to the left side of his head, I noted agonal breathing from the suspect. Ofc. Richardson applied pressure to the wound. I searched the right side pockets on the suspect and emptied any items found on his person to the ground where he was downed. Chillicothe Medics arrived to the scene and took over medical care of Deputy Kocheran and the suspect. I had stood over the suspects firearm and ensured that it was not disturbed until I was instructed to clear the scene.

I stood by for scene security until advised I could clear by command staff.

My body camera deactivated due to low battery power at some point during this incident.

I have nothing further at this time.

Supplement Narrative By Brock Yoder, 11/17/22 22:44

I was dispatched to the rear of the LEC in reference to a deputy shot. Upon arrival, I noted Ofc. Daubenmire outside the rear doors standing over an unknown male with an obvious grievous gunshot wound to the cranial area. I entered the rear of the LEC and observed several people standing over a deputy, who had a gunshot wound to the chest. I had already verified the Chillicothe FD had been dispatched. I saw that the deputy was being given appropriate medical care and I requested supplies.

I also checked on the unidentified male who was down outside the LEC. I noted Ofc. Richardson was attempting to provide medical aid to this individual. I checked him and found he had no pulse and was not breathing.

Ross County Sheriff's Office personnel were on scene. RCSI took over the immediate portion of the investigation and summonsed BCI to the scene.

Dispatcher Matson provided me with a trash bag she stated contained the gloves she was wearing when she was treating the deputy. She advised she was told to turn these over for BCI. I took possession of the trash bag and turned it over to Adair of the RCSI.

Supplement Narrative By Blair Strange, 11/17/22 22:48

I was dispatched to 28 N. Paint St. in reference to a report of a deputy who had been shot. Upon arrival, I observed an unknown male, lying on the ground outside the rear entrance to the LEC. The male appeared to be bleeding from his head. Officers had already placed the male in a recovery position and requested paper towels for wounds. I entered the rear of the LEC and noted a deputy lying on the floor in the hallway. There were several people around him, who appeared to be administering aid. I brought paper towels back outside to Officers with the unknown male. Myself and Officers Stanton assisted in taping off a crime scene with caution tape. Per command staff I responded to ARMC with Chillicothe Fire/EMS. I stood by at ARMC until told to clear by command staff Nothing further.

Supplement Narrative By Traevon Williams, 11/21/22 10:00

On November 17, 2022 while in off duty status, I was notified of a shooting at the Ross County Law Enforcement Complex Center. I dressed in the standard issued uniform of the day and responded to the LEC and assisted in perimeter security of the scene until I was advised my assistance was no longer needed. I took no further actions in this investigation.
