GENTLEMEN:—I have examined the transcript of the proceedings of the council and other officers of the village of Newcomerstown, relative to the above bond issue.

and find the same regular and in conformity with the provisions of the General Code.

I am of the opinion that a bond for said issue with combined principal and interest coupons attached, drawn in accordance with the bond ordinance authorizing the same and in compliance with the resolution of the Industrial Commission adopted under authority of section 1465-58a G. C. will, upon delivery, constitute a valid and binding obligation of said village.

Since the passage of the resolution of purchase by the Industrial Commission, the council of the village of Newcomerstown in order to meet the requirements of the Griswold act has amended its bond ordinance wherein the date of the bonds and the maturity thereof are changed. The new bond ordinance provides that the bonds shall bear date of June 20, 1922, and that they shall fall due one each year on January 1st, in the years 1924 to 1932, both inclusive. I suggest that the resolution of purchase be amended to comply with the bond ordinance as amended.
