
Investigative Activity: ATF Firearm Trace Reports

Narrative:

On Thursday, July 08, 2021, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received a "Firearms Trace Summary," also known as an "e-trace" report, from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about one of the firearms that Kevin Giesel possessed during the incident on June 14, 2021. Over the next several weeks, additional ATF e-trace reports were received by SA Lieber. A summary of those details is below:



Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) check of the weapon was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if any of the weapons were reported as being stolen.
