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APPROVAL—AGREEMENT, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS, WITH THE NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY, LESSEE OF THE CLEVELAND, CINCINNATI, CHICAGO AND ST. LOUIS RAILWAY COMPANY, INSTALLATION OF PROTECTIVE DEVICE OVER GRADE CROSSING TRACKS, STATE HIGHWAY NO. 853, PROXIMITY OF GRAFTON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval as to form and legality a proposed agreement by and between the State of Ohio, acting by and through John Jaster, Jr., Director of Highways, and The New York Central Railroad Company, lessee, of the railway and property of The Cleveland, Cincinnati, Chicago and St. Louis Railway Company, providing for the installation of a protective device at the grade crossing over the tracks of the Cleveland, Cincinnati, Chicago and St. Louis Railway Company, located at a point on State Highway No. 853 about two miles east of Grafton, in Lorain County, Ohio.
