DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a lease purporting to grant to David Lentz, 92.65 acres of land situated in Section 16, Township 15 and Range 3, in Columbiana County, Ohio. It seems that this lease is executed for the purpose of renewing the original lease which was granted to William Shinn by the trustees of Salem Township, Columbiana County, Ohio, September 28, 1821. The former lease it seems was executed in pursuance to a special act passed January 27, 1817, which provided for the trustees of the Township leasing such premises for the period of ninety-nine years, renewable forever.

It seems that the former lease has been assigned a number of times and that the said David Lentz is now the holder of the original lease by assignment.

Finding said lease in proper legal form I have this day noted my approval thereon and return the same herewith.
