APPROVAL—TWO GRANTS OF EASEMENT, NUMBERS 2161 AND 2162, STATE THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, BY A. T. GAMBLE AND JESSIE M. RENNER, DESIGNATED LAND, SUGAR CREEK TOWNSHIP, ALLEN COUNTY, OHIO, USE, PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval two grants of easement Nos. 2161 and 2162 executed to the State of Ohio by A. T. Gamble and Jessie M. Renner respectively in Sugar Creek Township, Allen County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said township and county.

By the above grants there are conveyed to the State of Ohio, certain lands described therein, for the sole purpose of using said lands for public fishing grounds, and to that end to improve the waters or water courses passing through and over said lands.

Upon examination of the above instruments, I find that the same have been executed and acknowledged by the respective grantors in the manner provided by law and am accordingly approving the same as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon, both of which are herewith returned.
