SYLLABUS:

1. Teachers in the public schools may be employed to transport pupils to or from school; such teachers may also enter into a contract with the board of education for such purpose; if the teacher is employed for the purpose of transporting pupils under a contract of hire, such teacher would be an "employe" within the meaning of the Workmen's Compensation Law of Ohio, and the amount paid the teacher for transpor-
